SWEET BASIL HOSTS 90TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION FOR TRUMPETER DOC CHEATHAM

On Tuesday, June 13th, 1995 Adolphus "Doc" Cheatham turns 90 years old and Sweet Basil, where Doc has hosted the Sunday afternoon brunch for 15 years, will celebrate with a rare mid-week performance by Doc and his quartet.

As an eyewitness to, and participant in at least 70 years of American musical history, Doc Cheatham born on Tuesday, June 13th 1905 in Nashville Tennessee, is a living testament to the diversity and vitality of the jazz, blues and Latin music landscapes.

Who else has played with Bessie Smith and Ma Rainey, subbed for Louis Armstrong, gigged with Fletcher Henderson, Cab Calloway, Billie Holiday, Benny Goodman, Machito, Perez Prado and Tito Puente? Who else maintains such a high level of musical charm and resourcefulness? Who else is Doc Cheatham.

Doc and his quartet with Chuck Folds on piano, Earl May on bass, and Jackie Williams playing drums will perform two sets at 8:00 and 10:00 pm. There is a \$15 music charge and a \$10 minimum. An invitation only reception will precede the performance.
