AWARDS

The following awards are announced by various departments of the University

AMERICAN HISTORY ESSAY CONTEST.—Scoring five points, Phi Delta Theta fraternity placed first among campus groups in the fifteenth annual contest sponsored by the Sons of the American Revolution, thereby winning possession for the coming year of a bust of Washington designed by Bianchini. A silver medal is awarded to Kermit Bue of Moscow as first prize for his essay, "Currency of the Colonial and Revolutionary Periods." Second prize, also a silver medal, is awarded to Dan Aherin of Genesee for his essay on "The Constitution and its Predecessors." A silver medal is awarded as third prize to Rose Mary Cullen of Pocatello for her essay "The Puritans, Wise and Otherwise."

PHILO SHERMAN BENNETT prize for the best essays dealing with "The Principles of Free Government." First prize is awarded to William C. McGowan, Jr., Monrovia, California; second prize to Virginia Tweedy of Caldwell.

CIVIL ENGINEERING.—Junior membership in the American Society of Civil Engineers is awarded to Gomer Condit of Hagerman for his paper "Soil Stabilization with Asphalt Emulsions" in the contest sponsored by the Spokane section of the society.

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING. — Junior membership in the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, plus \$5 in cash, is awarded to Walfred Carlson of Moscow for his paper on "High Speed Engine Indicators" in the contest sponsored by the Spokane section of the society. Junior membership in the society is awarded Dale Schubert of Fruitland for his paper on "Design of an Air Compressor."

ELECTRICAL ENGINEERING.—In competition with students at the State College of Washington, a paper on "A Thyratron Voltage Regulator" by Leroy Tillotson of Kellogg receives first prize of \$15 in the contest sponsored by the Spokane section of the American Society of Electrical Engineers.

GEORGE DAVIS BIVIN FOUNDATION.—Awards for the best papers on some phase of "The Relationship of the Emotions to the Mental Health of the Child." Kent McQueen of Preston is winner of the \$65 prize in the graduate division. The \$35 prize in the undergraduate division is awarded to Velma Patton of Palouse, Washington.

CARL SCHURZ MEMORIAL FOUNDATION.—A three-volume set of the works of Adalbert Stifter is awarded to Loren Glenn Strawn of Cascade for "distinctive work in the field of Germanics or Cultural Relations."

FRENCH SCHOLARSHIP.—A silver medal given by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the French Republic is awarded to Virginia McDonald of Burley as the student "most proficient in the French language and literature."

LAW SCHOLARSHIP.—A copy of Ballentine's Law Dictionary with Pronunciation is awarded to Paul B. Ennis of Pocatello by the Lawyers' Cooperative Publishing Company for making the highest grade in the course in Legal Bibliography.
