



## PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The President's Medallion, an award initiated by President Bob Hoover in 1998, is to be presented at University of Idaho Commencement Plenary Ceremonies in May and December. Recipients are individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind. At the December 2001 Commencement, we are honoring one extremely deserving individual.



Antone Minthorn, Board of Trustees Chairman, Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation (CTUIR).

Antone Minthorn, a Cayuse Indian, has served as chairman of the Board of Trustees for the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation since December 1997. In this role as the top elected official for the CTUIR tribal government, he leads a tribe that is known for its cooperative and innovative approach to issues. Prior to being elected board chairman, he spent 15 years as chair of the tribe's General Council, which is the voting membership.

Before becoming an elected official, he was a staff planner for the tribe, helping to develop the first Comprehensive Plan, which has effectively guided the tribe's development and growth for the past 20 years.

Minthorn has played an influential role in many of the tribe's successes, including restoration of salmon to the Umatilla River after a 70-year absence, development of a modern reservation economy, and re-acquisition of tribal land.

He is an active member of the Democratic Party, representing Oregon as a delegate at five National Democratic Conventions. He also serves, or has served, on the boards for the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians, Northwest Area Foundation, Oregon Trail Coordinating Council, Oregon Historical Society, Crow's Shadow Institute, and the George St. Denis American Legion Post.

Minthorn served in the U.S. Marine Corps from 1957-60, then attended Gonzaga University and graduated from Eastern Oregon State College.



**William D. Hansen** was sworn in as the Deputy Secretary of Education on May 24, 2001. In this post, Mr. Hansen serves as the Department of Education's chief operating officer and the principal adviser to Secretary Rod Paige on programs, policies, management and budget matters.

He was formally nominated as Deputy Secretary by President George W. Bush on April 23, 2001, and unanimously confirmed by the Senate a month later on May 22.

Bill Hansen also served as the Education Department transition team director for the Bush-Cheney Transition.

Prior to his appointment as Deputy Secretary, Mr. Hansen served as president and CEO of the Education Finance Council, working to expand educational opportunities by assisting students to pursue their dreams of a postsecondary education. In this capacity, Mr. Hansen managed the interests of organizations

that held more than \$40 billion in student aid. He also has served on several state and national boards and commissions on reforming elementary and secondary schools and increasing access to higher education, including the National Commission on the Cost of Higher Education.

He is an 11-year veteran of the Education Department, and previously served as deputy director of public affairs at the Department of Commerce and head of the intergovernmental and industry affairs office at the Department of Energy.

A native of Pocatello, Idaho, Hansen holds a B.S. degree in economics from George Mason University in Fairfax, Virginia.

#### Gowns-

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator —gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

#### Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

#### Hoods-


The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, of course, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

#### Honor Cords-

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Silve Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the university commencements.

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
