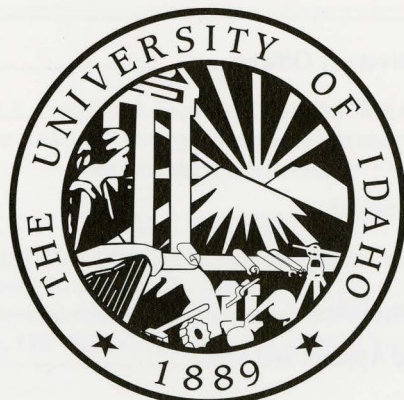

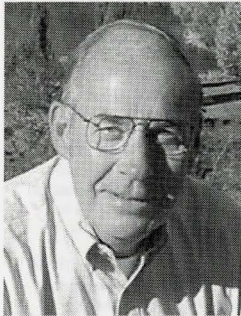

The President's Medallion, an award initiated by President Bob Hoover in 1998, is to be presented at University of Idaho Commencement Plenary Ceremonies in May and December. Recipients are individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind. At the December 2002 Commencement, we are honoring one extremely deserving individual.



**Richard J. Naskali**, Arboretum Director, University of Idaho

Most will agree that the University of Idaho has a beautiful campus, and one of its showpieces is the 63-acre Arboretum and Botanical Garden. Its evolution has been an intensive labor of love by its director, Richard J. Naskali. His creative and physical efforts for 15 years have transformed undeveloped land into a specimen-rich landscape now popular for weddings, literary readings, outdoor concerts, nature walks, picnics and meditation for the campus and community.

Richard, who earned a doctoral degree in botany from Ohio State University in 1969, began his career at UI 35 years ago in botany and plant anatomy. After 20 years of teaching, research and greenhouse management, he became director of the Arboretum in 1987. His driving goal was to fulfill the master plan for the arboretum to become a living-learning classroom. Today, plants from Asia, North America and Europe, display gardens, ponds, pathways, benches and commemorative groves and plantings fill the site.

As the director, Richard helped shepherd volunteer labor and private fund raising that support the arboretum's acquisitions and maintenance. In partnership with the Arboretum Associates, Richard and volunteers have helped raise more than \$750,000.

He has been recognized for his guest lectures, exquisite botanical photography, expert consulting on ornamental horticulture and garden tours throughout the world. But, his legacy for generations to come is the aesthetic mark he has made on a corner of the University of Idaho campus.

Thank you, Richard, for your generous gift of time and talent to shape this public asset.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

**Gowns-**

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator—gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

**Caps-**

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor’s tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

**Hoods-**

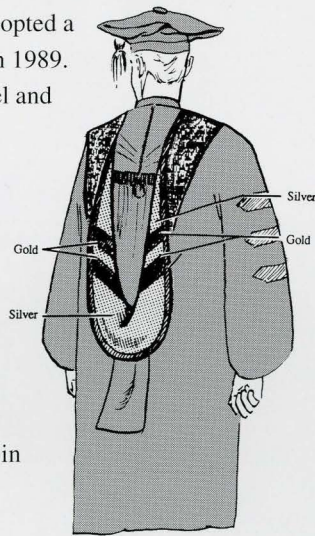
The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor’s gown is worn without a hood. A master’s hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor’s hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer’s branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

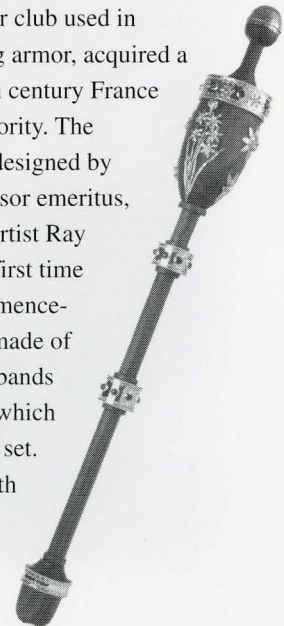
**Honor Cords—**

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortar-board. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university’s centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the university commencements.



The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
