Kirby Dyess, Vice President and Director of Operations for Intel Capital, Retired For 23 years, Kirby Dyess was an executive for Intel Corporation and then Intel Capital, the chip-makers' strategic investment group, which managed more than 50 Intel mergers and acquisitions. She now is a principal in Austin Capital Management that helps Pacific Northwest startup companies invest and grow. Prior to Intel, Dyess directed the Diagnostic Products Division at ICN Medical Laboratories Inc. in Portland for 10 years, based on her research in endocrinology, diabetes and metabolism.

Her commitment to higher education includes sitting on the boards of Oregon Health & Science University and Oregon State Board of Higher Education. She also is on advisory boards for other Oregon colleges.

Ms. Dyess is a graduate of the University of Idaho, being one of the first women students to graduate with a bachelor's degree in physics. She has pursued post-graduate work in biochemistry and business at Portland State University and Stanford University.

HONORARY DEGREE

Honorary degrees may be awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or UI graduates.



Thor H. Kiilsgaard, nationally recognized professional, dedicated public servant, alumnus. Thor Kiilsgaard was a geologist with the U.S. Geological Survey during most of his professional career. He twice retired from the Survey, most recently in 1993, but continues to volunteer for that agency under their Scientist Emeritus program.

Prior to serving in the Marine Corps, Mr. Kiilsgaard graduated from the University of Idaho with a bachelor's degree in geology. While a Marine, he served in the Pacific campaign and received bronze and silver stars and two purple hearts. Following his military stint, he returned to school and received a master's in geology from the University of California, Berkeley.

Prior to his distinguished and illustrious career with the United States Geological Survey, he was a geologist with the Idaho Bureau of Mines and Geology – now the Idaho Geological Survey – at the University of Idaho. One of his most notable international works was leading

the USGS Saudi Arabian Mission. His leadership led to significant discoveries of mineral deposits and laid the groundwork for many years of mineral exploration.

His service to the University of Idaho is exemplary, having served on the College of Mines and Earth Resources Advisory Board and being chosen an outstanding College alumnus. He was named by Governor Andrus as an Idaho Honorary State Geologist, only the second time this award has been given. He also is the recipient of the University of Idaho Silver and Gold Award.

Thor Kiilsgaard represents the finest tradition of great enthusiasm and capability. He has been an inspiration to others throughout his career, even as he continues to contribute his time and expertise to the USGS in Spokane and to the College of Science.

In recognition of a lifetime of exemplary service to the nation, state and university, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Mr. Kiilsgaard, a most distinguished citizen, the degree of Doctor of Science.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Cowns.

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator —gowns of bachelor's have pointed sleeves; those of master's have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctor's have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods-

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords—

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the University's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the

University commencements.

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
