

Commencement Speaker - Don Burnett

Don Burnett is the College of Law Dean and Foundation Professor at the University of Idaho. Under Burnett's leadership, law students are introduced to a high standard of professionalism and code of honor as soon as they step over the threshold of the Menard Law Building on the Moscow campus.

Burnett recently earned the Idaho State Bar's Professionalism Award, considered to be one of the highest honors a lawyer can receive during his or her career. The award recognizes demonstrated and uncommon devotion to public service, the improvement of the administration of justice and a career-long demonstration of diligence, ability, civility, integrity and dignity.

Burnett earned a bachelor's degree in economics, graduating magna cum laude from Harvard University; a juris doctorate from the University of Chicago; a master of laws degree (L.L.M.) from the University of Virginia; and graduated on the Commandant's List from the Command and General Staff College of the U.S. Army.

During his diverse career, he has served as: clerk to the Chief Justice of the Idaho Supreme Court; a practicing lawyer; Idaho State Bar president; judge of the Idaho Court of Appeals; assistant attorney general for the State of Idaho; and as an educator and administrator, serving as dean of the Louis D. Brandeis School of Law at the University of Louisville in Kentucky before accepting the dean's post at the University of Idaho in 2002.

HONORARY DEGREES

Honorary degrees may be awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or Idaho graduates.

In recognition of a lifetime of excellence and their many contributions to the state of Idaho, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Carol Campbell Renfew and Charles Hummel, most distinguished citizens, the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.



Carol Campbell Renfrew, arts/humanities patron and alumna

Arts and humanities events on the Palouse always have the support of Carol Renfrew '35. She is known as a fixture at concerts, literary readings, lectures and exhibits, especially at her alma mater.

Renfrew graduated from the University of Idaho with an economics degree. During her time at Idaho, she was a member of the Vandaleers, Phi Beta Kappa, Mortar Board and Kappa Alpha Theta.

Renfrew now spends her time attending the Auditorium Chamber Music Series concerts, the Idaho Repertory Theatre performances and exhibit openings at the Prichard Art Gallery. She is a member of the Pleiades Club, the oldest women's organization in Moscow that works to promote literary exchange. She also is actively engaged in raising funds for the 1912 Center and the Kenworthy Performing Arts Center.

She has dedicated her time and talents to the Latah Care Center Board of Directors, the Moscow-Latah County Library Board, the Latah County Historical Society Board and the Gritman Hospital Board.

She is a recipient of the Jim Lyle Volunteerism Award, 1993; the University of Idaho Foundation Volunteer of the Year Award, 1996; Idaho Treasure Award, 1997; and the Distinguished Idahoan Award, 2006.

"Carol's sustained contribution to the life of our community has been remarkable," said Kurt Olsson, department chair of English at the University of Idaho. "In her many contributions to who we are, Carol embodies the best spirit of this place and its people."



Charles Hummel, retired architect and community volunteer

Many of the Catholic churches of Idaho have a Hummel stamp, of sorts. The family firm of Hummel, Hummel and Jones designed most of the Catholic churches in the state during the 1940s, '50s and '60s.

"I can think of no living Idahoan who has done more for the profession of architecture in our state than Charles," wrote Arthur A. Hart, director emeritus of the Idaho State Historical Society.

His father, Frederick F. "Fritz" Hummel, and grandfather, Charles Frederick Hummel, also were architects who together became one of the most significant architectural firms in Idaho's history. Their family design portfolio includes, yet is not limited to, the State of Idaho Capitol building; the University of Idaho Administration Building; Bishop Kelly High School and St. John's Cathedral, in Boise.

Charles graduated from Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., with a bachelor's degree in architecture and earned a master's degree in architecture from Columbia University. He also served in the 100th Infantry Division as corporal lieutenant in the European Theater of Operation in the mid-1940s. Hummel later served in the U.S Army Corps of Engineers as second lieutenant in the early 1950s.

Through the years, he's been active in giving back to his community, including roles as president of the Boise Art Association, Boise Rotary Club and the Boise Philharmonic Association; vice chairman of the Boise City Planning and Zoning Commission; director of the Greater Boise Chamber of Commerce; and chairperson of the Board of Directors of St. Alphonsus Hospital.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns-

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator —gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods.

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords-

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by **Emeritus Professor Edmund** Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the university commencements.

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
