

GUEST SPEAKER



Steven B. Daley-Laursen '79, '84, Dean of the University of Idaho College of Natural Resources and Professor in the Department of Forest Resources.

Steven Daley-Laursen has 28 years of experience working in land-grant universities. He began his career as a research associate at the University of Idaho in 1979. He joined Montana State University and the University of Montana in 1984 as an assistant professor and natural resources Extension specialist. From 1988 to 2002, he worked at the University of Minnesota in several capacities, including Extension professor, director and co-founder of the Interdisciplinary Center for Environmental Learning and Leadership, director of the statewide Regional Sustainable

Development Partnerships Program, director of the Sea Grant College, program leader for Natural Resources and Environmental Programs with the University of Minnesota Extension Service, special assistant to the president, and associate dean in the College of Natural Resources.

His areas of academic and administrative concentration are leadership theory in natural resource management and environmental education; technology transfer processes between scientists and management agencies; and organizational and institutional design for sustainable development and sustainability. He has worked throughout the United States and in 11 other countries.


In 2002, Dr. Daley-Laursen became dean and professor for the College of Natural Resources at the University of Idaho. He oversees a college with more than 800 graduate and undergraduate students, 140 faculty and staff, and leading research, education and outreach initiatives with impact in Idaho, the West and the world. The college just established the nation's first undergraduate wildland fire ecology and management program. Faculty, staff and students are actively involved in the University's sustainability efforts and in three significant new universitywide, interdisciplinary initiatives. The college houses the Laboratory for Conservation and Ecological Genetics, the Reveley Geo-Spatial Technologies Complex, the Taylor Ranch Field Research Station in the Frank Church Wilderness and the McCall Outdoor Science School on the University's McCall campus.

Daley-Laursen received the Secretary's National Honor Award from the U.S. Department of Agriculture for his work on an environmental science education program on the White Earth Indian Reservation. He was an inaugural fellow in the Mondale Emerging Leaders Public Policy Program at the University of Minnesota, and an inaugural fellow in the Kellogg Foundation National Leadership Program at the University of Wisconsin. He currently is the national public policy chair for the National Association of University Forest Resources Programs and has held several leadership positions at the national, state and local levels in the Society of American Foresters and the National Association of State Universities and Land-Grant Colleges.

Daley-Laursen studied international relations at the College of William and Mary, and earned a bachelor's in conservation and resource development from the University of Maryland. He earned a master's in forest resources management and a doctorate in forest science from the University of Idaho in 1979 and 1984, respectively.

PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The University of Idaho President's Medallion is awarded to recognize outstanding contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people. This uncommon recognition is given to those who have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind. This is a specially commissioned medallion minted in Idaho from Idaho silver.



V. Lane Rawlins, a noted economist and academic leader, is the President Emeritus and Professor of Economic Sciences at Washington State University. In addition, he serves as the interim director of the William D. Ruckelshaus Center, a joint effort of WSU and the University of Washington.

Rawlins served as Washington State University's ninth president from 2000 - 2007. He is the first WSU president to have been a member of the university's faculty earlier in his career.

As president, he led one of the nation's most productive research universities, classified with 95 of America's leading public and private universities with very high research activity by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching.

During his presidency, student enrollment and admission standards reached all-time highs. Research funding also reached new levels, and WSU experienced a substantial increase in the enrollment of high-ability students.

Under Rawlins' leadership, the university's campuses in Pullman, Vancouver, Spokane and the Tri-Cities evolved into a University system in which WSU's regional campuses had greater flexibility to meet the needs of their communities. And more than \$300 million in construction took place including major facilities for research in shock physics and biotechnology.

Rawlins' commitment to quality public higher education in a research environment was a key factor in promoting partnerships with the University of Washington. Together they advocated for increased enrollment and research funding to benefit the state's economy.

Rawlins' association with WSU began in 1968, when he joined the university faculty in the Department of Economics as an economist. He chaired the department and later, served as WSU vice provost. He then served as vice chancellor of the University of Alabama System and for nine years as president of the University of Memphis before returning to WSU.

Born in southeastern Idaho, Rawlins completed his bachelor's degree in economics at Brigham Young University in Utah and earned a doctoral degree in economics from the University of California Berkeley. Rawlins is a labor economist by training and much of his research work focused on the effects of education on earnings in people's lives. He published widely in major journals and co-authored books that include "Public Service Employment: The Experience of a Decade."

He and his wife, Mary Jo, have three children and 11 grandchildren. Rawlins enjoys fly-fishing, golf, history and literature. The Rawlins' have a vacation cabin in eastern Idaho and now make their home in Lewiston, Idaho.

SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC APPAREL AND MACE

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator —gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining- the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming- the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:


Honor Cords

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxfordstyle mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the university commencements.

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa

flowers.
