

GUEST SPEAKER



Katherine G. Aiken '73 personifies the University of Idaho's legacy of leading. Aiken earned a bachelor of arts degree in history from the University, and now, her career path has brought her to the top leadership position in the college from which she earned that degree.

As dean of the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences, Aiken leads the University of Idaho's largest and most diverse college with more than 4,000 students and more than 30 academic programs.

Aiken joined the Idaho faculty in 1984 after earning a master's degree in history from the University of Oregon and a doctoral degree in history from Washington State University. At Idaho, she has taught courses in U.S. history at the introductory level and specialized in 20th century social and cultural history. She served as History Department chair from 2001-2005 and was appointed Dean of the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences in 2006.

Aiken has contributed to the University's academic leadership by instilling a sense of passion

and discovery in her students. She blended her own avid enthusiasm for baseball with her passion for history to offer a course on "The History of Baseball." In 1998, she was selected with two other faculty members as the first University Humanities Fellows as part of a program to foster excellence in teaching the humanities. Her dedication in the classroom resulted in several teaching awards: the University Award for Teaching Excellence; the ASUI Outstanding Faculty Award; and the Phi Kappa Phi Distinguished Faculty Award.

Dean Aiken is the author of articles dealing with Gracie Pfost, Idaho's first woman member of the United States Congress; environmental history; 20th century Idaho history; and the Coeur d'Alene mining district. Her books are "Harnessing the Power of Motherhood: The National Florence Crittenton Mission, 1883-1925" (University of Tennessee Press, 1998) and "Idaho's Bunker Hill: The Rise and Fall of a Great Mining Company, 1885-1981 (University of Oklahoma Press, 2005). She collaborated with Idaho State University colleagues Kevin Marsh and Laura Woodworth-Ney to co-write a short history of Idaho under the auspices of the Idaho State Historical Society – "Idaho: The Enduring Promise" (Cherbo Press, 2006).

Dean Aiken is a member of the Idaho Humanities Council Executive Committee and the State Department of Education Professional Standards Commission.

PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The President's Medallion is presented to individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind.



Keith Allred is a fifth-generation Idahoan. He has taught and conducted research on leadership, particularly in the areas of negotiation and conflict resolution, at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government, and also was a faculty member of the Program on Negotiation at Harvard Law School. Before joining the faculty at Harvard, Allred was on the faculty at Columbia University.

The driving force in Allred's professional life is his passion for government by the people, which was kindled by his undergraduate studies in American history at Brown and Stanford universities. Struck by the American founders' identification of the "problem of faction" as the chief obstacle to successful popular government and their assessment that the problem was rooted in human nature, he pursued a doctoral degree in organizational behavior and social psychology at UCLA. His research has focused on the causes and consequences of vicious cycles of contention in human relationships, or as the founders would have called it, factionalism.

Although he continues to teach in executive programs at Harvard and Oxford universities, has increasingly focused his career on finding practical ways to address the excesses of special interest and partisan politics. As a professional mediator, Allred has helped manage and resolve public lands, hydroelectric dam, tribal and land use disputes. As a consultant and trainer he has worked for local governments, state and federal agencies, and the governments of Canada and Northern Ireland.

In 2003, Allred was motivated to pursue real world solutions in his home state, and he and his family moved back to Idaho. A year later, Allred conceived of and then founded *TheCommonInterest.org*, a non-partisan citizens' organization that works in the Idaho legislature to put common sense solutions ahead of special interest and partisan politics. The Common Interest's work has been embraced by leaders and citizens from across the political spectrum and the organization quickly established a record of legislative successes. The Common Interest now has more than 1,300 members – Republicans, Democrats and Independents – from every corner of Idaho.

Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator – gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining – the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming – the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead Gold of the traditional Oxfordstyle mortarboard. The cap silv and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the University commencements.

The mace, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
