

### President M. Duane Nellis

M. Duane Nellis began serving as the University of Idaho's 17th president on July 1, 2009. During his first year in office, he has led the University to record student enrollments, bolstered the University's research mission, and extended University programs that help the people of the state educationally and economically. Also, President Nellis also has brought the University community together to develop a new Strategic Action Plan for 2011-15.

As the University's chief executive officer, President Nellis provides robust and engaging leadership for the University of Idaho. He provides support to 42 statewide extension offices and University

center locations in Boise, Coeur d'Alene and Idaho Falls. He works with the WWAMI (Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana and Idaho) Medical Education program to ensure that Idaho is supported, along with the 20 first-year medical students on the Moscow campus each year. Nellis also is engaged with the University alumni, friends, donors, faculty, staff and students around the world to create a University that is more entrepreneurial, sustainable, international, interdisciplinary and diverse.

Previously, President Nellis served as provost and senior vice president at Kansas State University where he oversaw 12 deans and 10 other units, including the offices of the vice provost for information technology services and the vice president for research. He also served for seven years at West Virginia University as dean of the Eberly College of Arts and Sciences, WVU's largest academic college.

President Nellis was appointed by Gov. C L. "Butch" Otter as a commissioner of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. He has held other professional leadership positions as well, including the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities Academic Officers Executive Council; president of the Association of American



Geographers; National Council for Geographic Education; Gamma Theta Upsilon, the international geographic honor society: Kansas Academy of Sciences; and member of the National Council of Colleges of Arts and Sciences Research Universities Committee. President Nellis is recognized nationally and internationally for his research that utilizes satellite data and geographic information systems to analyze various dimensions of the earth's land surface. This research has been funded by more than 50 sources such as NASA, the National Geographic Society. the U.S. Agency for International Development, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. His

research has led to more than 100 articles and reports in a wide range of professional journals, and 15 books and book chapters. He has given more than 100 professional presentations and has been invited to speak at more than 60 universities and related settings internationally.

He also has been recognized nationally and internationally for his research and teaching through numerous awards from organizations such as the Association of American Geographers (AAG), AAG's John Fraser Hart Award for Excellence in Research, the Outstanding Contributions Award by the AAG's Remote Sensing Specialty Group, the Young Research Scholar Award by the Institute of British Geographers, the Kansas State University Outstanding Teaching Award and University Adviser of the Year Award.

President M. Duane Nellis is a native of the Northwest: he was born in Spokane, Washington. He met and married his wife, Ruthie, while pursuing his bachelor's degree in earth sciences/geography at Montana State University. He received his master's and doctoral degrees in geography at Oregon State University.

Scott Wood, Ph.D.

Scott Wood was appointed dean of the College of Science in April 2008, but his association with the University dates back to 1992 when he joined the University as an assistant professor of geochemistry in the then-College of Mines and Earth Resources. His administrative appointments with the college also include associate dean and interim dean.

Wood oversees an academic unit comprised of eight departments with 150 faculty and 50 staff members in Moscow and Idaho Falls, and with more than 1,000 students in Boise, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho Falls and Moscow. In fiscal year 2010, college scientists were responsible for nearly \$8.5 million in expenditures to conduct their sponsored research efforts.

Dean Wood has published more than 83 refereed journal articles, 13 book chapters, 23 refereed conference proceedings, and more than 150 conference abstracts. He has received competitive funding from the National Science Foundation, the U.S. Department of Energy, the Department of Defense, the American Chemical Society, the state of Idaho, NATO, the National Institutes of Health and private industry. His research interests include theoretical and experimental studies of the thermodynamics, kinetics and molecular mechanisms of aqueous processes and water-rock interactions, especially at elevated temperatures and pressures.

Wood has been recognized with numerous awards and honors, including the 2006 Distinguished Service Award from the Division of Geochemistry of the American Chemical Society. In 2004, he received the Julian Boldy Award for best paper in economic geology at the annual Joint Meeting of the Geological Association of Canada and the Mineralogical Association of Canada. University of Idaho honors include the inaugural Distinguished Faculty Award from the College of Science in 2005 and the Award for Excellence in Research in 1998.

Wood earned his bachelor's degree in geology and chemistry from Hamilton College. He received master's and doctoral degrees in geochemistry from Princeton University.

### SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC APPAREL AND MACE

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

#### Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator – gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

#### Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

#### Hoods

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining – the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming – the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

#### Honor Cords

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxfordstyle mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the University commencements.

The mace, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
