

### President M. Duane Nellis

M. Duane Nellis began serving as the University of Idaho's 17th president on July 1, 2009. During his first few years in office, he has led the University to record student enrollments, bolstered the University's research mission. and extended University programs that help the people of the state educationally and economically. Also, President Nellis has brought the University community together to develop a new, fiveyear strategic plan to move the University forward: Leading Idaho: The University of Idaho's Strategic Plan, 2011-2015.

As the University's chief executive officer, President Nellis provides robust and engaging leadership for the University of Idaho. He

provides support to 42 statewide extension offices and University center locations in Boise, Coeur d'Alene and Idaho Falls. He works with the WWAMI (Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana and Idaho) Medical Education program to ensure that Idaho is supported, along with the 20 first-year medical students on the Moscow campus each year. Nellis also is engaged with the University alumni, friends, donors, faculty, staff and students around the world to create a University that is more entrepreneurial, sustainable, international, interdisciplinary and diverse.

Previously, President Nellis served as provost and senior vice president at Kansas State University where he oversaw 12 deans and 10 other units, including the offices of the vice provost for information technology services and the vice president for research. He also served for seven years at West Virginia University as dean of the Eberly College of Arts and Sciences, WVU's largest academic college.

President Nellis was appointed by Gov. C L. "Butch" Otter as a commissioner of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. He has held other professional leadership positions as well, including the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities Academic Officers Executive Council; president of the Association of American



Geographers; National Council for Geographic Education; Gamma Theta Upsilon, the international geographic honor society; Kansas Academy of Sciences; and member of the National Council of Colleges of Arts and Sciences Research Universities Committee, President Nellis is recognized nationally and internationally for his research that utilizes satellite data and geographic information systems to analyze various dimensions of the earth's land surface. This research has been funded by more than 50 sources such as NASA. the National Geographic Society, the U.S. Agency for International Development, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. His research has led to more than 100

articles and reports in a wide range of professional journals, and 15 books and book chapters. He has given more than 100 professional presentations and has been invited to speak at more than 60 universities and related settings internationally.

He also has been recognized nationally and internationally for his research and teaching through numerous awards from organizations such as the Association of American Geographers (AAG), AAG's John Fraser Hart Award for Excellence in Research, the Outstanding Contributions Award by the AAG's Remote Sensing Specialty Group, the Young Research Scholar Award by the Institute of British Geographers, the Kansas State University Outstanding Teaching Award and University Adviser of the Year Award, as a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, and as a Distinguished Alumni Fellow Award recipient from Oregon State University.

President M. Duane Nellis is a native of the Northwest, born in Spokane, Washington. He met and married his wife, Ruthie, while pursuing his bachelor's degree in earth sciences/geography at Montana State University. He received his master's and doctoral degrees in geography at Oregon State University.

Lynn Baird, Ph.D.

Lynn N. Baird is the dean for Library Services at the University of Idaho. She has held the position since 2007. She began her employment at the University in 1974 and has held several leadership positions at the library, including: interim dean for Library Services (2006-2007); associate dean for Library Services (2005-2006); head, Access Services (1994-2006); head, Serials and Acquisitions Department (1978-1993).

Her educational path began at the University of the Pacific (Raymond College) where she majored in liberal arts in 1972. From there, she earned a M.L.S. at the University of Oregon in 1974; an M.P.A. at the University of Idaho in 1980; and her doctoral degree in Adult and Organizational Learning in 2010 from the University of Idaho.

Baird has taught in the Independent Study of Idaho program, to help teachers obtain their library science endorsement.


Baird has served the University of Idaho community well, with major University committee assignments that have included: the Morrill Act Planning Committee co-chair, Leadership Academy facilitator, Leadership Academy task force, Vice Provost of Academic Affairs periodic review committee chair, Interim Associate Vice President/CEO Coeur d'Alene search committee chair, Advisory Group on Information Technology research group chair and University Vision and Resources Task Force, among numerous other University and department committees. She also serves on national and state committees and organizations.

In her community, Baird has been active with Friends of the Moscow Public Library, Girls Scouts Inland Empire Council, Latah County Fair Board and the Moscow Planning and Zoning Commission.

In addition, she has presented non-credit classes, workshops and lectures, and has also been invited to give lectures at the University of Idaho, the region and across the country. She received the University's Athena Woman of the Year Award in 2010 and was nominated several years for the Award for Excellence in Outreach. She also is an active part of the DataONE (Data Observation Network for Earth) Sociocultural Work Group, a National Science Foundation grant group to bridge society and science needs.

Arthur F. (Skip) Oppenheimer

Arthur F. (Skip) Oppenheimer is the CEO of Oppenheimer Companies, Inc. His business acumen is widely recognized among the Idaho business community. He has used his business skills and connections to focus on economic development, and health and children's issues. He is a founder of the Idaho Business Coalition for Education Excellence, a group of 75 Idaho business CEOs and has been tireless in working to improve the quality of education in Idaho at all levels. He also has been involved with a number of state-level councils to work on issues such as teen pregnancy and behavioral health.



Now two years old, this symposium has been held in Boise the last two Octobers and has brought together speakers and panelists who discussed ethical issues in business, law and journalism.

His philanthropic interests include the Boise Philharmonic Orchestra, the Idaho Humanities Council, the YMCA and the Idaho Community Foundation. Oppenheimer served as the first chair of St. Luke's Health System board of directors and has continued to devote considerable time and effort to St. Luke's in a variety of ways. He is tireless in efforts to foster strong families and assist children, including contributing to the Governor's Coordinating Council for Families and Children and the Boy Scouts of America. He has a reputation as a person who is committed to family on a personal level and brings that commitment to the public setting.

Oppenheimer is a champion for the liberal arts. He has worked to promote the Log Cabin Literary Center in Boise. His article "A Businessman Looks at the Values of Liberal Arts," published in the ADE Bulletin, June 1982, provides a thoughtful discussion regarding the efficacy of these disciplines.

Perhaps, this reflects Skip Oppenheimer's combination of a bachelor of arts degree in history from the University of Idaho with an MBA from the Harvard Graduate School of Business Administration.

In addition, he is a member of the University of Idaho Foundation board of directors. All three entities have benefited from his wisdom and his commitment to the University of Idaho's success.

Concerned about ethical issues in both the media and in business, Oppenheimer sought to guarantee that Idaho students and the community at large had the opportunity to engage in programs designed to foster informed ethical decisions through the establishment of the Oppenheimer Ethics Fund. The annual Oppenheimer Symposium Ethics Symposium, held in Boise for the last two Octobers, attracted participants from the fields of journalism, law, public relations, advertising and government.

Beyond his contributions to councils and boards, Oppenheimer is unfailingly gracious and brings an intellectual engagement on a broad variety of topics.

Oppenheimer, also known for his keen sense of humor, gives back to his alma mater in other ways. A few years ago, he served as a very capable and entertaining host for a University of Idaho luncheon honoring National Merit Scholars

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

#### Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator – gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

#### Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

#### Hoods

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining – the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming – the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

#### **Honor Cords**

Honor cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret-styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxfordstyle mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the University's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the University commencements.

The mace, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
