# Citations on Retirement

## **FREDERICK L. CHAPMAN, PROFESSOR OF THEATRE ARTS**

Bringing the magic of theatre to the lives of Idaho's children is a primary focus of Frederick L. "Fred" Chapman's 13 years at the University of Idaho. He retires at the close of the academic year. The directing, acting and makeup skills he has shared with his students have widened their horizons and contributed to their many successes. Chapman earned a B.A. degree from Berea College, Berea, Kentucky, in 1949, his Master of Fine Arts degree from Tulane University in 1964 and his Ph.D. from that institution in 1971. He also studied at the University of New Castle-upon-Tyne in 1975-76. His teaching career includes the Riverside Military Academy, Gainesville, Georgia; U.S. Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland; Tulane University, and the University of Toledo, in addition to his years at UI. He came here in 1977 as chairman of the UI Department of Theatre Arts, stepping down to return to teaching in 1980. He also served as production manager for the Oregon Shakespearean Festival from 1961 to 1963 and was director of the Creative Arts Community in Toledo, Ohio, from 1974 to 1977. He is a member of the Educational Theatre Association, the Idaho Alliance for Arts Education, and the Northwest Theatre Association.

## **NELSON S. CURTIS, PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF ART**

The work of Nelson Curtis has influenced many students since he began teaching a variety of art-related subjects at the University of Idaho in 1969. He has taught design, sculpture, painting, jewelry making, drawing, art history and several special topics including bronze casting, stained glass and welding. He earned his bachelor of fine arts degree in 1963 from the Memphis Academy of Fine Arts and an MFA from UI in 1969. He served as chairman of the Art Department from 1970 to 1973. Curtis is a member of the Art Education Association, College Art Association of America, Idaho Art Association, Idaho Entomological Society, Lepidopterist's Society, Southern Society of Sculptors, and Evergreen Aurelians. He is co-author of a trainer's manual, an audio tape series and a trainee manual on "Systematic and Objective Analysis of Instruction." Freer has been honored with a faculty Alumni Award for Excellence and has had an article, "The Pudding's the Proof," selected as one of eight articles for the Feb. 1987 "Educational Leadership on Tape."

## **JOHN A. HENRY, EXTENSION PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF AGRICULTURE**

With 30 years service to the residents of Idaho, John Henry is retiring. He began work in the Idaho Cooperative Extension Service in 1963 as Bonneville County agent. From there, he moved to Teton County in 1965 and to Canyon County in 1969, where he has served since. He earned a B.S. in animal husbandry in 1954 and an M.S. in animal nutrition in 1962, both from the University of Idaho. Before entering the Cooperative Extension Service, he farmed and raised cattle in the Gooding area. Among his honors are the Epsilon Sigma Phi Outstanding Work Award, Idaho Honorary State Farmer Award, Search for Excellence Award from the National Association

## **HENRIK D. JUVE, JR., PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF CHEMISTRY**

Henrik Juve is closing a distinguished career in industry and higher education when he retires from the University of Idaho at the end of this year. He came to UI as a student, earning a B.S. and an M.S. in chemistry in 1950 and 1954. He worked as a chemist for Shell Oil Co. in Houston, Texas, and Potlatch Forests, Inc., and Omark-CCI, both in Lewiston, until returning to UI in 1977 as an instructional assistant, becoming a research assistant in 1979. He completed his Ph.D. degree at UI in 1982, and was appointed assistant professor in 1982. He has taught introductory chemistry courses since, and has worked as a consultant to Blount CCI during the summers. Juve has been a member of the Forest Products Society, Society of Manufacturing Chemists of Paints and Lacquers, the Idaho Academy of Science, and the American Institute of Chemical Engineers. ## **WILLIAM B. McCROSKEY, PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF ARCHITECTURE**

William "Bert" McCroskey has retired after touching the lives of hundreds of students in his 26 years of service at the University of Idaho. He came to UI in 1964 as instructor of architecture, leaving for four years to teach at Montana State University from 1966 to 1970 and returning to UI as an instructor and graduate student. He holds a bachelor of architecture degree from Montana State University and a master of architecture from the University of Idaho. In his years at UI, he not only taught many of the architecture subjects offered, but served as executive assistant to the president and to the Department Head of the School of Art and Architecture in 1977-78 and as associate dean of the College of Letters and Science from 1978 until 1990, when he returned to teaching in the College of Art and Architecture. He is a member of the American Institute of Architects, the Society of Architectural Historians and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. McCroskey served as president of the Northern Section of the Idaho chapter of American Institute of Architects in 1975, as director of the Idaho Historic Preservation Council and was Society of Architectural Historians Member of the National Preservation Committee from 1968 to 1970. OF HOME ECONOMICS**

Hundreds of University of Idaho students have memories of learning basic weaving techniques with Shirley Medsker during the 26 years she has taught School of Home Economics textiles classes. She is retiring at the end of this academic year. Medsker holds B.S. and M.A.H.Ec. degrees from Wayne State University, Detroit, Michigan, and has attended many workshops since completing her formal education, most of them with internationally known experts in weaving and use of color in textile design. Before coming to UI in 1967, she taught at Marygrove College and Wayne State. She is a member of the American Home Economics Association, Association of College Professors of Textiles and Clothing, Handweavers Guild of America and Palouse Hills Weavers Guild. **FREDERICK J. WATTS, PROFESSOR OF CIVIL ENGINEERING  
AND DEPARTMENT CHAIR EMERITUS**

One of Idaho's experts on the subject of runoff sediments is retiring. Frederick J.
