

Thomas O. Bell (Coeur d'Alene Center Commencement Guest Speaker) is President, Provost, Dean and Professor of Education Emeritus.

We celebrate the University of Idaho Coeur d'Alene Commencement Ceremony because of the leadership of Thomas O. Bell. The University of Idaho Coeur d'Alene could accurately be described as the house that Dr. Bell built. His vision and hard work initiated the programs available to this years' graduates. Honoring him is no overstatement, as almost all of the academic degrees we are now able to provide in northern Idaho were fostered under his guidance. And, he continues to be interested in and supportive of the center as it grows. Last summer, we planted and dedicated a Camperdown Elm tree in his honor on the Coeur d'Alene campus to remind us for years to come of his commitment to higher education in Idaho and the Coeur d'Alene area. We insist that he drop by often to inspect his tree and dispense encouragement – his trademark.

Dr. Bell began his service to Idaho education in 1953. He has been a leader as a teacher, coach, principal and superintendent in three Idaho schools districts. He came to the University of Idaho in 1966. He has served as Director of the Division of Teacher Education, Dean of the College of Education, Vice President of Academic Affairs and Research, Provost, and Interim President of the University of Idaho. He and his wife, Jody, and children lived in Guam and the Micronesian Islands of the Pacific as well as American Samoa and Australia, participating in the Northwest Regional Education Laboratory, providing research and development assistance to education programs. He is highly regarded for his dedication to education.



Elizabeth Sellers, (Idaho Falls Center Commencement Guest Speaker) manager of the U.S. Department of Energy's Idaho Operations Office. Ms. Sellers is directly responsible for 300 federal employees and has oversight of 6,500 contractor employees. The Idaho Operations Office is a multi-program lab involved in nuclear energy research, national security, environmental restoration technology development and application, and basic science research and development. Before accepting her current position in Idaho, she served as the manager of the U.S. Department of Energy's National Nuclear Security Administration's Kansas City Site Office. Elizabeth has been recognized as a key leader who promotes innovative concepts and accountability for federal and contractor performance.

Ms. Sellers joined the Department of Energy (DOE) in 1983 as a program engineer for nuclear materials production in Albuquerque, New Mexico, and quickly became

responsible for all nuclear material requirements within the DOE complex. In 1986, she served as a program engineer in the Weapon Programs Division where she worked on privatizing parachute production and the B90 research and development program. By 1989 she had moved to the Uranium Mill Tailings and Remedial Action Project as the Environment, Safety and Health manager. During her tenure she initiated several new waste policies before being promoted to team leader in the Environmental Restoration Project Office. In that post she was responsible for creating and institutionalizing the environmental management cleanup at four production facilities. In 1995, she became the director of the Spent Nuclear Fuel Project at the Richland Operations Office. This first-of-a-kind, \$1.6 billion project is the largest cleanup project ever performed under CERCLA by a federal agency.

Ms. Sellers holds a Bachelor of Science degree in chemical engineering from the University of New Mexico and a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from the University of Alabama. She has served on the board of directors and as president of the New Mexico Network of Women in Science and Engineering. She also completed a three-year Leadership in Training curriculum through the Department of Energy.

HONORARY DEGREES

Honorary degrees may be awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or University of Idaho graduates.



Thomas C. Wright (Moscow Commencement Guest Speaker and Honorary Degree recipient) is founder and CEO of the Wright Foundation.

As a lifelong educator, Tom Wright aspired to improve the lives of children through the preparation of teachers, particularly special education teachers.

After receiving his undergraduate and graduate degrees from the University of Idaho's College of Education, he began his career as a teacher. Although he found this rewarding, the demands of a growing family and the challenges of providing for a son with special needs led to his involvement with a school textbook company for more than 17 years.

During that time, he realized a critical need for better educational materials and founded the Wright Group in 1975, revolutionizing the textbook industry by combining quality text book development with teacher training programs. His company became

known as "America's Leader in Whole Learning." Teachers throughout the world have used the Wright Group materials to enhance the education of literally millions of students. In 1994, he sold the business to the Tribune Company of Chicago and served as the company's CEO until his retirement in 2000.

He has been a dedicated volunteer to his alma mater and serves as a member of the University of Idaho Foundation. In 2001, Tom was inducted into the University of Idaho Alumni Association Hall of Fame.

Through his generosity and with his vision, an innovative graduate program for K-12 teachers was established at the University of Idaho — the Wright Fellowships. This powerful program, which features an intensive and individualized course of study, has transformed the lives of the teachers and the way the College of Education provides teacher education.

In recognition of a lifetime of excellence, contributions and achievements for the betterment of all citizens, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Thomas C. Wright, a most distinguished alumnus, the degree of Doctor of Administrative Science.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The President's Medallion is presented to individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind. At the May 2005 Commencement, the University honors four extremely deserving individuals.



Delbert Farmer, community and business leader and former chairman of the Shoshone-Bannock Indian Tribe. Delbert Farmer received his bachelor's degree in animal science in 1970 from the University of Idaho.

As a strong advocate for higher education for Indian people, Mr. Farmer established an academic scholarship for members of the Shoshone-Bannock tribe. He is an artist with several pieces of art related to the Lewis and Clark Expedition in his portfolio. He is an active leader in the community, currently serving as revenue director for the tribe and as a representative of the tribe on commissions and committees such as the Lower Snake River Juvenile Salmon Migration Feasibility Study. He is a past member of the Fort Hall Business Council, dance team leader for the International Folkdance Festival and past chairman of the Shoshone-Bannock Festival.

The Shoshone-Bannock Tribe was part of the welcoming group for athletes and cultural ceremonies participants by special invitation of the 2002 Salt Lake City Olympics Organizing Committee. The tribe, under the direction of Mr. Farmer, was the representative for more than 500 tribes from across the United States.



The Honorable James A. McClure (Boise Center Commencement Guest Speaker) and Louise M. McClure.

Widely recognized for his expertise in energy and natural resources matters, particularly in the areas of mining, forestry, public land, water and general natural resource law, the Honorable James A. McClure represented the people of Idaho in the U.S. Congress for more than a quarter century. He was first elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1966, after serving three terms in the Idaho State Senate. He was elected to the U.S. Senate in 1972 and served there until his retirement in January 1991.

While in Washington D.C., he was chairman of the Senate Energy and Natural Resources Committee, the Senate Interior Appropriations Subcommittee, the Senate Republican Conference and the Senate Steering Committee. He also served on the Senate Rules Committee, the Senate Budget Committee and the Senate Environment and

Public Works Committee. He was a member of the Senate Select Committee investigating the Iran/Contra Affair, and was a member of the Helsinki Commission on Human Rights.

He also is widely recognized as an authority on nuclear, natural gas, oil and electrical energy matters as they relate to national and international policy. His concern about world energy needs first led him to the Middle East in the 1960s. Since that time, he has frequently traveled worldwide on energy and foreign policy matters.

A close personal friend of former President George Bush, he served as a "Bush for President" national campaign co-chairman. He also served as vice chairman of the Board of Trustees of the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C.

He was born in Payette, Idaho. After graduating from the University of Idaho College of Law in 1950, he was elected Payette County and City Prosecuting Attorney. He served three terms in the Idaho State Senate before being elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 1966.

Louise McClure was very active in Congressional circles. She combined her love for art and music with her interest in politics and community affairs.

She was raised in Nezperce, Idaho, on the family wheat farm. Neither farming nor politics played a particularly important role in her early life. Instead, it was her love of music. During her youth, she studied both the piano and the clarinet and took voice lessons. It was while majoring in music at the University of Idaho and singing as a soloist in the university's choral group, the Vandaleers, that she noticed an aspiring young law student singing with her in the group.

Throughout the years, Mrs. McClure's interest in the fine arts grew. In the early 1980s, she played an important role in the organization of a major exhibition of Idaho art at the National Museum of American Art in the nation's capital. She also served on the board for the National Endowment of the Arts.

Senator and Mrs. McClure's interest and support of the University of Idaho has remained a constant over the years. They currently serve as members of the University of Idaho Foundation and have served on various college advisory boards over the years.



Gary G. Michael, former Interim President of the University of Idaho and CEO of Albertson, Inc., retired.

At the urging of the Governor and the State Board of Education, Gary Michael assumed the responsibilities of interim president of the University of Idaho in July 2003. He left retirement—and the golf course—to lead the university until a permanent president could be appointed. He also took the post without remuneration, by his own choice.

Mr. Michael is recognized for his distinguished business career, rising to an elite rank among corporate executives in America, while maintaining a concentrated community involvement and commitment. His philanthropy is well known, and he is widely respected as a compassionate, principled leader who leads by example. He is a person of the highest ethical standards.

As former chairman of the board and CEO of Albertsons, Inc., Mr. Michael culminated his 34-year career with Albertsons in 2001. The retail food and drug chain has become the fourth largest in the nation, with more than 2,200 outlets and annual sales exceeding \$35 billion.

He also has been a leader in promoting excellence in education. A graduate of the University of Idaho, he has given unselfishly of his time, wisdom and financial support to his alma mater. He has been a member of the University of Idaho Foundation since 1975, serving under four different University presidents, before becoming the Interim President. He also chaired the College of Business and Economics Campaign Cabinet, which helped build the college's first permanent home, the J. A. Albertson Building. Through his leadership on *The Campaign for Idaho*, the University of Idaho surpassed its private fund-raising goal and raised \$128 million for scholarships, professorships, curriculum, technology and facilities in nearly half the time expected. The University and the state of Idaho will benefit greatly from these fund-raising efforts.

Mr. Michael also sits on numerous boards of directors, including IDACORP, Harrah's Entertainment, The Clorox Company, Questar, Inc., and Boise, formerly Boise Cascade Corp. He is a member of the Financial Executives Institution and is retired chairman of the board of directors for the San Francisco Federal Reserve Bank.

His recognized record of community service and his national prominence have brought great distinction to the state of Idaho.



Scott W. Reed, attorney and authority on water and environmental issues.

An attorney in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, Scott Reed is known nationally for his work in water and environmental issues. His areas of specialty include general civil and trial practice, business, commercial, land use, environmental law and local government law.

He has established a national reputation for his work on behalf of conservation, much of which is *pro bono*. Whether it has been at the local level through his membership on the Coeur d'Alene Planning Commission; at the state level as a member of the Idaho Water Resources Board; at the regional level as a member of the Board of Directors of the Western Environmental Law Center; or at the national level as a member of the Board of Directors of the National Audubon Society, Scott Reed has given selflessly of his many talents to help society as a whole.

A former Assistant U.S. Attorney, Mr. Reed was born in Klamath Falls, Ore. He graduated from Princeton University with an A.B.A. degree and Stanford University with an L.L.B. He was admitted to the Idaho Bar in 1956.

In addition to his previously mentioned activities, his public service includes the North Idaho College Board of Trustees, Board of Trustees of the North Dakota Wetlands Trust, Board of Advisors of the Northwest Water Law and Policy Project, Coeur d'Alene Library Board of Trustees, and Board of Directors of the Idaho Nature Conservancy.

He and his wife, Mary Lou, were named Idaho Conservationists of the Year by "Idaho Wildlife" in January 1984. He also received the Professionalism Award from the Idaho State Bar Association in November 1998.

ALUMNI HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES 2005

The purpose of the Alumni Hall of Fame Award is to recognize living alumni who have achieved national or international distinction by their accomplishments and leadership.



Carl Berry of Mill Valley, Calif., is a 1962 graduate from the College of Education. Berry is a national business leader in the resort property industry. He pioneered the urban component of the timeshare industry in North America more than two decades ago. Berry has been an active volunteer of the UI Foundation and served as co-chairperson of the National Campaign Council of the

Campaign for Idaho which raised more than \$128 million.



Dale Bosworth of Washington, D.C., is a 1966 graduate of the College of Natural Resources. In April 2001, Bosworth was named the 15th chief of the U.S. Forest Service. He has worked for the Forest Service for more than three decades, serving as regional forester of the Northern Region (northern Idaho, Montana and portions of North Dakota and South Dakota) from 1997-2001 and the

Intermountain Region (Utah, Nevada, southern Idaho and western Wyoming) from 1994-97. Dale and his wife, Carma, live in Washington, D.C., and have two grown children.



Gerald O. Bierwag of Tucson, Ariz., was a 1958 graduate of the College of Letters and Science. He passed away Feb. 15, 2005. Bierwag was a retired college economics professor who served on the faculty at the University of Oregon, University of Arizona and Florida International University. He specialized in Duration Analysis, which involves assessing interest rate risk on investment portfolios.



Allen Derr of Boise is a 1951 graduate with a bachelor's degree in journalism. He also earned a UI College of Law degree in 1959. He entered private law practice in 1960. In 1971, he successfully argued Reed vs. Reed, the first case in U.S. Supreme Court history to declare a state law unconstitutional because it discriminated against women and violated the 14th amendment. Allen

Derr is married to Judy Peavey-Derr (Ramseyer). The Boise couple has two adult children. He continues his private law practice in Boise.

Professor of Geological Engineering and Department Head Emeritus — February 2005 — By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns-

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator — gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods-

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords-

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.


The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by **Emeritus Professor Edmund** Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at

the university commencements.

Silver

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
