



# Steven D. Howe, Director of the Center for Space Nuclear Research Idaho Falls Center Commencement Speaker

Steve Howe is the first director of the Center for Space Nuclear Research (CSNR) in Idaho Falls. He also is currently a staff member in the Thermonuclear Applications group of the Applied Physics Division at the Los Alamos National Laboratory.

His undergraduate and graduate work was in the field of Nuclear Engineering at Kansas State University, and he conducted his thesis research at the Los Alamos Meson Physics Facility.

The CSNR is operated by the Universities Space Research Association (USRA), in collaboration with the Idaho National Laboratory (INL). The CSNR engages university scientists in research and development of advanced space nuclear systems that include space power and propulsion systems and radioisotope power generators. CSNR creates

opportunities for university researchers to collaborate with their counterparts at NASA, INL and other DOE labs, and with industry in projects and initiatives to advance nuclear technologies for space exploration and other space applications. The CSNR's research program covers both nuclear and non-nuclear elements and related sub-disciplines, such as materials, nucleonics, heat transfer, thermofluidynamics, structures, systems engineering, testing and diagnostics. The center conducts a multidisciplinary education program in studies of space nuclear systems and related scientific and technical areas that uses a mix of classroom and research activities.

Dr. Howe's research interests include antiproton physics and applications, nuclear rocket propulsion, hypervelocity aerodynamics and thermodynamics, and non-equilibrium x-ray emission. He has published more than 50 reports in the open literature, as well as nine classified reports. In addition, he is a fiction writer, and has published the novella, "Wrench and Claw," in Analog magazine and the novel, "Honor Bound Honor Born," which detailed the possible development of the first commercial base on the Moon. Dr. Howe also has appeared in numerous television programs about space and rocketry. His television credits include: "Living and Working in Space," PBS and Sci-Fi Channel; "Mission to Mars," Ultra Science and the Learning Channel; "Rocketships," Discovery Channel; "Rockets in Space," Wingspan; and "Voyage to the Milky Way," PBS.

Dr. Howe holds five patents that involve the storage and application of antiprotons, and he is the co-founder of Hbar Technologies, headquartered near Chicago. He has served on a number of national committees, the most recent of which is the National Academy of Sciences Committee on Space Missions Enabled by Nuclear Propulsion.



### Ben T. Ysursa, Secretary of State Boise Center Guest Speaker

Ben Ysursa was elected Idaho's 26th Secretary of State on November 5, 2002, with 77 percent of the vote. He took the oath of office on January 6, 2003. Mr. Ysursa started his professional career serving first as Deputy Secretary of State from 1974 to 1976 and then as Chief Deputy Secretary of State from 1976-2002. He has conducted numerous workshops on elections for county, city and district officials throughout the state and has authored various manuals.

The Secretary of State's office files articles of incorporation, Uniform Commercial Code Finance statements, trademarks, service marks and notary public appointments. As Secretary of State, he is a member of the Board of Land Commissioners and Board of Examiners, chairman of the Board of Canvassers and chief elections officer. Secretary

Ysursa serves on the National Association of Secretary of State's Executive Board.

Born in Boise, he is a 1971 graduate of Gonzaga University. He received his law degree from St. Louis University Law School in 1974 and was admitted to the Idaho State Bar in October 1974.

Mr. Ysursa was the recipient of the Boyd Martin Award presented by the Association of Idaho Cities, and the 1992 recipient for Outstanding Administrator from the Idaho Republican Party. He has served as a board member for various state and city committees, and as a volunteer for youth athletic organizations. He also is a member of the Basque Museum and Cultural Center.



## Louise Shadduck, author, public servant Coeur d'Alene Center Commencement Guest Speaker


Louise Shadduck was one of the 100 Idahoans honored by the Idaho Centennial Commission in 1990 at the Here We Have Idaho: People Make the Difference observance.

During the early 1960s, she was Idaho's Secretary of Commerce and Development, the first woman to serve in that position in any state in the country. Ms. Shadduck felt strongly that she owed a debt to other women to do the very best job she could, which she did throughout a rich governmental career. This included serving as aide to Governor C.A. Robins, Senator Henry Dworshak and Congressman Orval Hansen. She also worked as executive director of the Idaho Forest Industry Council.

Louise Shadduck's roots in the National Federation of Press Women (NFPW) reach back more than 40 years to 1958. She served as president of Idaho Press Women in 1966 and was named NFPW Woman of Achievement the following year. She went on to serve as NFPW president from 1971 to 1973. She was named NFPW Communicator of Achievement in 1994 and received the President's Award the same year. In 2000, she was honored as the NFPW Woman of the Millennium. She was presented an Honorary Doctor of Laws degree from the University of Idaho in 1969 and was inducted into the Idaho Hall of Fame that same year.

She is recognized throughout the state for her efforts in many community service projects, which includes bringing the National Girl Scout Roundup, the National Boy Scout Jamboree and America's first World Jamboree to Farragut State Park.

Whether in speeches or in print, Ms. Shadduck conveys the warmth and humor that are her trademarks. She has written several books, one of those about the immigrant sheep man, Andy Little. She felt his life and family embodied the friendliness of Idaho which she holds so dear.



# The Honorable Dirk Kempthorne, Governor of the State of Idaho, U.S. Secretary of Interior nominee, alumnus Moscow Commencement Speaker

Governor Dirk Kempthorne was re-elected as Idaho's governor in November 2002. He was first elected as Idaho's 30th chief executive in 1998, after a successful six-year term in the United States Senate. He has been nominated by President George W. Bush to the post of Secretary of Interior and is awaiting congressional confirmation.

Dirk Kempthorne began his commitment to public service as president of his residence hall at the University of Idaho. He also was elected student body president, and received his degree in 1975.

Governor Kempthorne was a highly successful mayor of Boise from 1985-92. He then was elected U. S. senator from Idaho. As a senator, he wrote, negotiated and

won passage of two major pieces of legislation: a bill to end unfunded federal mandates on state and local governments, and a substantial revision of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. He also worked to improve the quality of life for American active duty military personnel, reservists, their families and veterans.

During his tenure as governor, he has put forward initiatives to foster rural economic development, promote more overseas marketing of Idaho products, and greater integration of the state's scientific, educational and business communities to ensure that Idaho's diversifying economy continues to expand. And Idaho's children are a priority. Upon taking office, he declared an initiative for the "Generation of the Child," to ensure that Idaho children are healthy and well educated.


Governor Kempthorne has worked to develop consensus on management of Idaho's and the West's natural resources. He has worked with his colleagues in Oregon, Washington and Montana to develop an historic bipartisan agreement on a state-based solution for returning salmon runs in the region.

He has been recognized by his peers as a national leader. His colleagues elected him as chairman of the National Governor's Association in August 2003. In this role, he has launched an initiative to bring a national focus on the looming crisis of long-term care.

He also has served as president of the Council of State Governments, and chairman of the Western Governors Association. He serves on the Executive Committees of the National Governors Association and the Republican Governors Association. Former U.S. Secretary of Education Rod Paige appointed Governor Kempthorne to the National Assessment Governing Board and former Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security Tom Ridge appointed him to the Homeland Security Task Force.

# HONORARY DEGREES

Honorary degrees may be awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the State of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or UI graduates.



# Jerry L. Evans, former State Superintendent for Public Instruction and alumnus

Jerry Evans epitomizes the qualities of the honorary degree recipient - noteworthy public service, advancing the principles of academic excellence and public education, and significant contributions to the state of Idaho.

After receiving a degree from the University of Idaho, Mr. Evans began his career as an educator. He served as principal and superintendent prior to being elected to the position of Idaho State Superintendent for Public Instruction in 1978; he was re-elected four times. He believed that all Idaho children were entitled to a quality education, and he never strayed from this conviction.


Because of his leadership, knowledge and advocacy, Mr. Evans made an enormous difference in the quality of education for the citizens, and students, of Idaho. Revered by

the educational community, he is widely recognized as a person of vision, competence, integrity and action, and an influential statesman. He is credited for advancing educational reform and renewal, and funding equality in the state of Idaho.

Mr. Evans' work was principle-driven. One of the hallmark tests of the importance of an issue was the question, "Does it make a difference in the lives of children?" To him, any activity, policy or practice was important only if it produced the answer "yes" to this question. Another test he applied was whether a proposal was good for "all of the children all of the time." Regardless of political context or pressures, he operated on these and similar guiding principles. Mr. Evans was willing to challenge public policies and practices to develop better educational opportunities for children.

In retirement, he continues to provide counsel to educators and legislators who value his expertise and judgment. He is recognized as one of the most knowledgeable educators in the nation with respect to school finance. He is one of the few educators who understands the impact of the intricacies of school finance practices on educational programs and services and the impact on economic development on the principles of democracy.

In recognition of a lifetime of contributions to public education and to the state of Idaho, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Jerry L. Evans, the degree of Doctor of Administrative Science.



# Robert R. Furgason, Director, Harte Research Institute for Gulf of Mexico Studies, alumnus.

Bob Furgason is widely acknowledged as a creative, influential and thoughtful leader. He personifies the outstanding characteristics of a successful University of Idaho graduate.

Dr. Furgason earned both his bachelor's and master's degrees in chemical engineering at the University of Idaho, then complete his doctoral work at Northwestern University. He began his notable career as a teacher while in his master's program, and returned to the University of Idaho as a faculty member following completion of his doctorate.

He served his alma mater as head of the Department of Chemical Engineering, dean of the College of Engineering and vice president for Academic Affairs and Research.

He left the University to serve as vice chancellor for Academic Affairs at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, and then assumed the presidency at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Dr. Furgason recently stepped down from the presidency to assume duties as the director of the Harte Research Institute for Gulf of Mexico Studies, which is dedicated the sustainable use and conservation of the Gulf of Mexico.

His tenure at the University of Idaho was marked by vision, resourcefulness and innovation. He introduced creative programs to assist with the increasing and changing student body, and strengthened the University's mission and quality of service. Always a proponent of women in higher education, especially in the engineering fields, he created the Women-in-Engineering Program to encourage junior high and high school students to enter these areas of study.

He is widely recognized as a dynamic leader. His outstanding leadership in higher education and loyal dedication to the people and institutions he served were hallmarks throughout his career. He is a tireless advocate

for education, minority access to education and to his profession. He is recognized by his peers as a principled, steady and brilliant leader, with a sense of modesty, compassion and humor.

Bob Furgason is known for effective use of the four A's of leadership: "Anticipate, thinking forward and trying to see what direction you want to go . . . analyze, knowing what you are doing . . . acting and making a decision when to act, procrastination is your worst enemy . . . and adapt, learning from your mistakes and adapting." Many friends and colleagues have benefited from his vision. One friend credits his "engineering background, combined with his amiable personality, for his ability to marshal the troops and gather the means to accomplish his vision."

In recognition of a lifetime of contributions to higher education and the betterment of humankind, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Robert R. Furgason, the degree of Doctor of Administrative Science.

At the May 2006 Commencement, we are honoring four extremely deserving individuals.



# Clen and Emma Atchley, Alumni and Ranchers President's Medallion Recipients

Clen and Emma Atchley own and manage the Flying A Ranch in Ashton, Idaho, a successful seed potato operation that celebrated its centennial in 2001. Both are University of Idaho graduates; Clen received a bachelor's degree in agriculture in 1966, and Emma earned a bachelor's degree in English in 1968 when she received the prestigious Theophilus Outstanding Senior Award.

Emma Atchley became a UI Foundation member in 1990. Ten years later, she was elected Foundation president. She served on the Agricultural Biotechnology Campaign Committee from 1998 to 2001, and helped raise nearly \$6 million, double the original goal. She also

served as a UI Alumni Association board member and was board president in 1987.

Clen and Emma Atchley were named the UI Foundation's Volunteers of the Year in 2002 for their long-term leadership as volunteers for the University of Idaho. Their efforts to support the University through their time and talents epitomize the many valued opportunities that exist for alumni to give back to their alma mater.

Clen Atchley has served the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences in a number of volunteer positions. He has been a member of the Ag Consulting Council, now known as the Dean's Advisory Board, for a number of years. He also was a founding member of the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences Alumni and Friends Association Board of Directors, and served as board president in 1999 for a two-year term. As a member of the board, he has been a key member who has assisted the college in events and student recruitment activities in southeast Idaho. He also was appointed to the college's Centennial Task Force, which met throughout 2000-01 to plan college centennial activities throughout the state.

The Atchleys recently were presented with the prestigious 2005 Environmental Stewardship Award by the National Potato Council.



# The Honorable Peter T. Cenarrusa, former Idaho Secretary of State President's Medallion Recipient

Pete Cenarrusa was born in Carey, Idaho, to immigrant parents from Biskaia Province of the Basque Country.

He is a graduate of the University of Idaho College of Agriculture, and was a member of the University's 1940 Intercollegiate National Championship Boxing Team. After graduation, he started the first agricultural classes in the Cambridge and Carey school districts.

Mr. Cenarrusa served during World War II as a Marine naval aviator and a Corsair fighter pilot, and earned a rank of major. He began his political career as an Idaho State Representative and served nine terms, with three terms as Speaker of the House. He was appointed May 1, 1967, as Secretary of State and was elected to eight terms.

He is a lifetime farmer, rancher and woolgrower who has championed agriculture in all facets of government. He has been inducted into five halls of fame: Agriculture, Athletic, Idaho, Republican and Basque. He was awarded the Prestigious Basque of the World medal in January 2000 in Bilbao, Basque Country.

Mr. Cenarrusa retired as Secretary of State in January 2003 after serving more than 52 years in constitutionally elected public service. After his "retirement," he assisted and funded the organization of the Cenarrusa Center for Basque Studies in Idaho. The center operates as an academic and research program that offers a Basque Studies minor through a consortium of universities. The program is designed to raise awareness about the Basque culture through classes in language and culture; publication of literature about Basque issues; participation in seminars, symposia and conferences; and collaboration with cultural centers and universities in the United States and the Basque Country. The center sponsors the public expression of its research and coursework in collaboration with the Basque Museum and Cultural Center in Boise, Idaho.



# James A. "Sandy" Emerson, Executive Director of the Coeur d'Alene Chamber of Commerce

### **President's Medallion Recipient**

The University of Idaho takes great pride in claiming James A. "Sandy" Emerson as a graduate, along with several members of his immediate family, including his wife, Jeanne.

A native of Coeur d'Alene, he has made significant contributions to his local community and the state. As executive director of the Coeur d'Alene Chamber of Commerce, he established the Chamber Leadership Program and the successful Upbeat Breakfast series. He has been an active member of the Kootenai County Parks and Waterways Advisory Board, the Chamber Natural Resource Committee, and has helped to organize public tours of the Silver Valley-Coeur d'Alene River Basin Clean-up project

and Lake Coeur d'Alene osprey habitat.

Mr. Emerson is a member and two-term president of the Idaho Fish and Wildlife Foundation, and currently serves on the Resource Committee for the Bureau of Land Management. As an active Rotarian, he has been instrumental in organizing community service projects that include fundraising campaigns for City Fire Department equipment and Trails of the Coeur d'Alenes informational kiosks. He spearheaded the design and construction of highway beautification projects. He served on the Coeur d'Alene School Board, was an original member of the Kootenai County Task Force on Human Relations and active in the Human Rights Education Institute.

Mr. Emerson has made an enormous impact in the Coeur d'Alene community. His hard work, passion and volunteer spirit to a wide variety of projects have benefited the city, region and state. His volunteerism is enormous, and his love for this community is immense. He brings people together to work collaboratively on projects to improve the quality of life for all. He has done so much on a cumulative basis, year after year, on a broad scope of activities and involvement. His commitment truly makes him a role model for all of us.

# Alumni Hall of Fame Inductees 2006

The purpose of the Alumni Hall of Fame Award is to recognize living alumni who have achieved national or international distinction by their accomplishments and leadership.



Carl Berry of Mill Valley, Calif., is a 1962 graduate from the College of Education. Berry is a national business leader in the resort property industry. He pioneered the urban component of the timeshare industry in North America more than two decades ago. Berry has been an active volunteer of the UI Foundation and served as co-chairperson of the National Campaign Council,

helping to raise more than \$128 million for the University's Campaign for Idaho. He was selected in 2004 for induction into the University of Idaho Alumni Hall of Fame.



Minoru "Min" Hironaka of Moscow, is a 1952 graduate in range management. He is a honored professor emeritus of rangeland ecology and management. Hironaka has made significant contributions to the art and science of rangeland management as a discipline. His research findings in studying the sagebrush ecosystem led to the publication of "Sagebrush-grass"

Habitat Types in Southern Idaho," which has become a classic in the field. He has received several honors from the Society for Range Management, including the Renner Award, the highest accolade of the organization. Hironaka spent much of his career at UI as a professor. He now is retired and lives in Moscow. He was selected in 2005 for recognition into the University of Idaho Alumni Hall of Fame.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

#### Gowns-

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator — gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelors and masters gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

#### Caps-

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the masters and specialists tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

#### Hoods-

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. **Lining-** the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). **Trimming-** the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

#### Honor Cords-

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze cords designate graduation cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by **Emeritus Professor Edmund** Chavez in the university's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the university commencements.

The MACE, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace, designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner, was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
