President M. Duane Nellis


M. Duane Nellis began serving as the University of Idaho's 17th president on July 1, 2009. During his first two years in office, he has led the University to record student enrollments, bolstered the University's research mission, and extended University programs that help the people of the state educationally and economically. Also, President Nellis has brought the University community together to develop a new Strategic Action Plan for 2011-15.

As the University's chief executive officer, President Nellis provides robust and engaging leadership for the University of Idaho. He provides support to 42 statewide extension offices and University

center locations in Boise, Coeur d'Alene and Idaho Falls. He works with the WWAMI (Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana and Idaho) Medical Education program to ensure that Idaho is supported, along with the 20 first-year medical students on the Moscow campus each year. Nellis also is engaged with the University alumni, friends, donors, faculty, staff and students around the world to create a University that is more entrepreneurial, sustainable, international, interdisciplinary and diverse.

Previously, President Nellis served as provost and senior vice president at Kansas State University where he oversaw 12 deans and 10 other units, including the offices of the vice provost for information technology services and the vice president for research. He also served for seven years at West Virginia University as dean of the Eberly College of Arts and Sciences, WVU's largest academic college.

President Nellis was appointed by Gov. C L. "Butch" Otter as a commissioner of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. He has held other professional leadership positions as well, including the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities Academic Officers Executive Council; president of the Association of American



Geographers; National Council for Geographic Education: Gamma Theta Upsilon, the international geographic honor society: Kansas Academy of Sciences; and member of the National Council of Colleges of Arts and Sciences Research Universities Committee. President Nellis is recognized nationally and internationally for his research that utilizes satellite data and geographic information systems to analyze various dimensions of the earth's land surface. This research has been funded by more than 50 sources such as NASA, the National Geographic Society. the U.S. Agency for International Development, and the U.S. Department of Agriculture. His

research has led to more than 100 articles and reports in a wide range of professional journals, and 15 books and book chapters. He has given more than 100 professional presentations and has been invited to speak at more than 60 universities and related settings internationally.

He also has been recognized nationally and internationally for his research and teaching through numerous awards from organizations such as the Association of American Geographers (AAG), AAG's John Fraser Hart Award for Excellence in Research, the Outstanding Contributions Award by the AAG's Remote Sensing Specialty Group, the Young Research Scholar Award by the Institute of British Geographers, the Kansas State University Outstanding Teaching Award and University Adviser of the Year Award.

President Nellis is a native of the Northwest: he was born in Spokane, Washington. He met and married his wife, Ruthie, while pursuing his bachelor's degree in earth sciences/geography at Montana State University. 

GUEST SPEAKERS

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – MOSCOW



John Clayton

Four-time Grammy nominated bassist/composer/conductor **John Clayton's** talents are consistently requested by the movers and shakers in the jazz industry, such as Quincy Jones and Tommy Lipuma. Clayton also shares his world-class talents with young musicians in Moscow each February, where he serves as artistic director of the University of Idaho's Lionel Hampton Jazz Festival.

Clayton is lauded for the sheer wizardry of his arco bass playing, the patience he exhibits with his students, the provocative notes he chooses when he composes, the empathy he shows, and the scintillating sounds he coaxes from musicians when he conducts-all of which pale in comparison to his charisma.

Clayton has written and arranged music for Diana Krall, DeeDee Bridgewater (including her Grammy award-winning CD "Dear Ella"), Natalie Cole, Milt Jackson, Nancy Wilson, Quincy Jones, George Benson, Dr. John, Regina Carter and others. He has been commissioned by many ensembles including the Northwest Chamber Orchestra, the American Jazz Philharmonic, The Iceland Symphony, The Metropole Orchestra, The Carnegie Hall Big Band, The Richmond Symphony, the WDR Orchestra, and the Amsterdam Philharmonic.

On the other hand, he was awarded a platinum record for his stirring arrangement of "The Star-Spangled Banner" performed by Whitney Houston during the Super Bowl in 1990. He has won numerous awards such as the Golden Feather Award given to him by the legendary Leonard Feather and the Los Angeles Jazz Society's Composer/ Arranger award. Most recently, he won a Grammy award for his arrangements on Queen Latifah's record, "Trav'lin' Light."

In addition to Idaho's Hampton Festival – where Clayton has served as the musical director – he also directs several other jazz festivals including the Sarasota Jazz Festival and the Santa Fe Jazz Party. As artistic director of the Vail Jazz Workshop, he participates in choosing talented students from across the nation for an intensive week of learning jazz.

Clayton's serious study of the double bass began at age 16, when he studied with famed bassist Ray Brown. At age 19, John was the bassist for Henry Mancini's television series "The Mancini Generation." Later he completed his studies at Indiana University in 1975, graduating with a bachelor of music in double bass. The Clayton-Hamilton Jazz Orchestra is co-led by John, his brother, saxophonist, Jeff Clayton, and drummer, Jeff Hamilton. John co-leads the Clayton Brothers Quintet with his brother, Jeff, as well.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – BOISE

A native of Pocatello, Idaho, **Don Burnett** is the College of Law Dean and Foundation Professor at the University of Idaho. During Burnett's deanship, the College has adopted a pro bono service requirement for all law students, reflecting its commitment to high standards of professionalism and honor. The College has established curricular emphases in natural resources and environmental law, including the interdisciplinary "Waters of the West" program; Native American law; litigation and appropriate dispute resolution, including mediation; and business law and entrepreneurism. The College also has implemented a third-year program in Boise, advancing the University's unique statewide mission in legal education and complementing the University's full three-year law degree program in Moscow.

Burnett has earned the Idaho State Bar's Professionalism Award, Outstanding Service Award, and, in 2009, the Distinguished Lawyer Award – considered to be one of the highest honors a lawyer can receive during his or her career. Burnett has chaired the Professionalism Committee of the American Bar Association Section on Legal Education and the University of Idaho Steering Committee on Diversity and Human Rights. He currently chairs the University's Ethical Guidance and Oversight Committee.

Burnett earned a bachelor's degree in economics, graduating magna cum laude from Harvard University; a juris doctorate from the University of Chicago; and a master of laws degree (LL.M.) from the University of Virginia.

He graduated on the Commandant's List from the Command and General Staff College of the U.S. Army, later receiving the U.S. Armed Forces Legion of Merit Award for exceptionally meritorious service in a succession of key assignments as a Reserve officer in the Judge Advocate General's Corps.

During his civilian career, Burnett has served as: judicial clerk to the Chief Justice of the Idaho Supreme Court; assistant attorney general for the State of Idaho; lawyer in private practice; Idaho State Bar president; judge of the Shoshone-Bannock Tribal Court; judge of the Idaho Court of Appeals; and as an educator and administrator, serving as dean of the Louis D. Brandeis School of Law at the University of Louisville in Kentucky before returning to his native state to accept the dean's post at the University of Idaho in 2002.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – IDAHO FALLS

Sam Shakir is the president and chief executive officer of AREVA Enrichment Services, a wholly owned subsidiary of AREVA Group. He oversees the development of the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility in Idaho, one of AREVA's largest capital investments in the world. The multi-billion dollar state-of-the-art facility will enrich uranium for use as fuel in commercial nuclear power plants. The project will break ground in 2011 and begin first phase commercial operation in 2014.

Prior to joining AREVA, Shakir worked with ABB in the nuclear power sector and at the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant in Maryland, operated by Baltimore Gas and Electric. Prior to that, he spent five years working for leading Canadian engineering consulting and construction firms responsible for major commercial and office developments in Canada and the U.S. After joining AREVA in 1998, Shakir held various positions including vice president of sales and strategy for spent fuel management, where he helped the company become the leading U.S. supplier in spent fuel storage solutions. He also served as director of strategy for the U.S. backend sector with focus on developing strategies and working with industry stakeholders on how to best implement recycling of light water reactor fuel in the U.S. Shakir also was a project manager for implementing spent fuel storage facilities at a number of reactor sites and was a product manager responsible for developing innovative designs of on-site storage of spent fuel and developing a network of U.S. and global commercial suppliers for manufacturing critical components that met the exacting standards demanded by the technology itself and fitted for use in the nuclear industry. In his current role, a team of industrial and business experts to license, design, build, and ultimately operate AREVA's new flagship enrichment facility in Idaho. Shakir earned a bachelor's degree in engineering from Concordia University in Montreal and a master's in business administration from the Haas School of Business at the University of California Berkeley.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO - COEUR D'ALENE

Senator Shawn Keough represents Idaho's Legislative District One, which includes northern Bonner and Boundary counties. First elected in 1996, Keough is serving her seventh term. She serves on the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee, is vice-chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, and also serves on the Senate Transportation Committee.

Keough also serves on numerous regional and statewide committees including the Resource Advisory Committee for Idaho Panhandle National Forests, the Advisory Committee of the Idaho Education Network, Governor's Transportation Task Force, Governor's Rural Economic Development Task Force, Governor's Coordinating Council for Families and Children, and the Western Legislative Forestry Task Force. She also served on University of Idaho Presidential Search Committee in 2008-09.

Keough has more than 25 years of experience in the fields of business management and public relations. Since 2000, she has served as executive director for the Associated Logging Contractors, an organization of independent logging contractors.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – MOSCOW, COLLEGE OF LAW

Wendy J. Olson became the U.S. Attorney for the District of Idaho on June 25, 2010. In 1997, she joined the U.S. Attorney's Office and was serving as its senior litigation counsel at the time of her appointment as U.S. Attorney. During her 13 years as an assistant U.S. Attorney, she prosecuted white collar crime, crimes involving the sexual exploitation of children, and criminal civil rights violations. Prior to joining the U.S. Attorney's office, Olson was a trial attorney in the Criminal Section, Civil Rights Division, U.S. Department of Justice in Washington, D.C. She also served as assistant to the legal director of the National Church Arson Task Force and as a law clerk for U.S. Chief District Court Judge Barbara Rothstein in Seattle from 1990-92.

Born and raised in Pocatello, she graduated from Pocatello High School in 1982. She earned a bachelor of arts degree in news/editorial journalism from Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa, and a juris doctorate from Stanford Law School. She and her husband, Craig Kreiser, have two daughters.

HONORARY DEGREES

An honorary degree is awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or University of Idaho graduates.

Dr. Forrest Morton Bird is an American physician, inventor, aviator, pioneer, educator, author, biomedical engineer and Renaissance man. He has helped save numerous lives with his inventions of some of the most reliable mass-produced mechanical ventilators. His invention of the Baby Bird® respirator for infants helped reduce mortality rates from 70 to less than 10 percent for infants with respiratory problems.

Dr. Bird is also an avid aviator, who first soloed at 14; flew in World War II; and later, while researching ways to fly at high altitudes, discovered clinical applications for his breathing devices.

By 1955, after having attended numerous medical schools and completed diverse residencies, he developed the prototype Bird Universal Medical Respirator for acute or chronic cardiopulmonary care. He tested the device by traveling in his own airplanes to medical schools and asking doctors for their most ill patients. In each case, known therapies had failed and the patient was expected to succumb to cardiopulmonary failure.

A true inventor and entrepreneur, Dr. Bird holds more than 200 patents and founded Bird Corporation in 1954 and now is the founder and owner of Percussionarie Corporation, based in Sandpoint, Idaho. Based on his research, the company developed a number of advanced breathing-related devices, including the Mark 7® Respirator, which provided the patient with volume ventilation.

Dr. Bird is president of Bird Space Technology in Sandpoint, Idaho. He and his wife, Dr. Pamela Bird, are founders of the Bird Aviation Museum and Invention Center, located on their northern Idaho ranch. This unique aero-medical museum features a rotating collection of more than 20 unique aircraft, rare vintage cars and a display of inventions from Bird and others. The Bird Aviation Museum and Invention Center strives to educate visitors about the historic contributions of aviators and innovators who have helped create modern technology, and celebrate these individuals who have forever changed the way we live.

Dr. Bird has been honored with several prestigious awards, including the Presidential Citizens Medal in 2008, presented by President George W. Bush in a ceremony in the Oval Office. In 2009, he received the National Medal of Technology and Innovation from President Barack Obama.

Dr. Bird also has received medical degrees from Pontifical University, Brazil, and a doctor of science degree from Northrop University, California. He earned his doctorate in biomedical engineering in 1976 from California Western University. He also was inducted into the National Inventors Hall of Fame in 1995.

In recognition of his contributions to medical technology and aviation, to the University of Idaho, to the state of Idaho and nation, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Dr. Forrest Morton Bird the degree of Doctor of Science.

Louise Miller McClure grew up in the small farming town of Nezperce, Idaho. Her talent for music was evident at a very early age and she sang at many community functions. She was valedictorian of the graduating high school class of 1946, and that fall, she enrolled at the University of Idaho to study voice and major in music with a minor in education.

She pledged Delta Delta Delta and quickly became a campus leader. She was active in the School of Music as a Vandaleer and as a member of Sigma Alpha Iota, the national professional music honorary for women. She was a member of Phi Beta Kappa and of Spurs. She also served on the Panhellenic Council and was secretary of her class.

In 1950, Louise married Jim McClure and embarked on a shared lifelong commitment to public service. During Jim McClure's years in the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate, Louise was actively engaged in

congressional wives organizations, hosted diplomats, senators, and members of Congress and volunteered countless hours to a number of organizations.

Louise McClure has given much of her time to help her University. Along with her husband, she served on the advisory boards for the College of Letters, Arts and Social Sciences; the Martin Institute; and the University of Idaho Lionel Hampton Jazz Festival. She also has served on the University Foundation, the Foundation Board of Directors, and the 2003 Strategic Initiatives Committee. In 2001, the McClures established the James A. and Louise McClure Endowment for the Sciences and Public Policy and later the McClure Center, which fosters rational debate on issues important to the state, the region, and the nation and conducts thorough research, publishes reports of findings and provides public forums.

Her service to the University has been honored in many ways. In 2009, the University of Idaho recognized the McClures as some of Idaho's most treasured alumni by presenting them with the University's first Legacy of Leading Award at a gala in Boise.

Louise has always been involved in public service. She has served on the board of the Boise Philharmonic, Parents and Youth Against Drug Abuse, and the Women's and Children's Alliance. She is active in Daughters of the American Revolution, Daughters of the Nile and the Philanthropic Educational Organization. Louise is also an active member of the board for the Idaho Humanities Council.

In 2010, her and her husband's lifelong contributions to the arts were recognized with the Idaho Governor's Arts Award for Lifetime Achievement.

In recognition of her public service and contributions to the arts, to the University of Idaho, state of Idaho and nation, the University of Idaho is proud to confer upon Louise McClure, a most distinguished citizen and leading alumnus, the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

The President's Medallion is presented at University of Idaho Commencement Ceremonies in May and December. Recipients are individuals who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, and have provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the wellbeing of humankind.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – BOISE

Kaye Knight, who received her education degree from Idaho, has made a career of community involvement. She has been a member of the Junior League for 40 years, serving in numerous leadership and mentoring roles. Kaye initiated and directed the Meridian School Volunteers; previously, there had been no program allowing parents to volunteer in the Meridian Schools. For seven years, she served Ada County as a zoning commissioner, a planning commissioner and a member of the Board of Adjustment. As the president of the Idaho State Medical Society Auxiliary, Kaye successfully lobbied the legislature for the first children's seat belt restraint bill. Continuing her focus on the welfare of children, she served as president of the Board of Directors of Idaho Ronald McDonald House, and the chair of the Nominating Committee on the Women's and Children's Alliance Board of Directors. Not neglecting the arts, Kaye also served as president of the following organizations: Morrison Center Auxiliary, Friends of the Philharmonic and Boise Philharmonic Association Inc. Board of Directors. Kaye has also served on the Advisory Board for the College of Education at the University of Idaho. For her extensive service to the community, Kaye has received awards and recognition from the Idaho Statesman, Boise Junior League, the Silver Sage Council of the Girl Scouts of America, and the Women's and Children's Alliance.

Dr. Lawrence Knight graduated in pre-med at the University of Idaho and completed his medical degree at the University of Washington. His specialty of pathology led him to serving as the chief pathologist in the Oklahoma City VA Medical Center, chief pathologist at St. Luke's Hospital in Boise, consulting pathologist at St. Alphonsus Hospital in Boise and Holy Rosary Hospital in Ontario, Ore., as well as the chief of Laboratory Services and as consulting pathologist of the Boise VA Medical Center. Lawrence was a founding partner of Treasure Valley Laboratory in Boise, and has served as an officer in the U.S. Army Reserve Medical Corps. He has served as president of the Ada County Medical Society, the chair of the Idaho Medical Association, chair of the Red Cross Blood Services (Lewis and Clark), a member of the Executive Committee of the Mountain States Tumor Institute, and an instructor in pathology at the University of Washington. He has held officer positions in Kiwanis International, Women's and Children's Alliance, and the Citizens' Advisory Board of the Idaho National Laboratory. Lawrence has served on Boards of Directors of the University of Idaho Alumni Association, the University of Idaho Foundation and the Vandal Boosters. He also received the President's Circle Leadership Award for his financial support of the University of Idaho.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – IDAHO FALLS

Harold W. Davis has a full slate of community service commitments, including many years with the Boy Scouts of America in a variety of leadership roles. He served locally on the boards of Idaho Falls Symphony, Chamber of Commerce, Habitat for Humanity, Child Development Workshop and the board of American Indian Services.

He served on the advisory boards of Idaho Falls LDS Hospital, Sacred Heart Hospital, LDS Social Services and Idaho Falls Park View Hospital. Harold also served as chairman of Idaho Falls Civic Auditorium Organ Fund and United Way, and co-chairman of the Miracle Network Telethon.

Previously, he was superintendent of the City of Idaho Falls Electric Light Division, and was an electrical engineer with Philips and for Sandia Corp. In his professional role, he has served on the national advisory boards of GTE-Sylvania, Square D and the National Association of Electrical Distributors.

He received a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering from Texas A&M.

Enid Lee Davis also has served her community with distinction. She was president of the Bonneville County Republican Women's Club. She served as conference coordinator for the Idaho Falls District Conference for the American Mothers Inc., and served as district coordinator for the same organization. She also served on the nurturing committee for Habitat for Humanity.

She has served on the boards of American Indian Services, Idaho Falls Symphony, Idahoans' Concerned about Adolescent Pregnancy, the YMCA, and the Bonneville County United Way. With her husband, Harold, she co-chaired the Medical Miracle Network Telethon.

At the state level, Enid served as legislative committee co-chair for Families Supporting Adoption – Idaho, Counseling Licensure Board member, president of the American Association of Women, and a member of the Governors' Task Force on Children.

For the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Enid has served in many roles, including: teacher, relief society president, primary president, young women president, Cub Scout den mother, and drama director. She also served on a humanitarian mission to the Philippines with her husband, on a humanitarian mission to Romania, and as a missionary to the LDS Texas-Louisiana Mission.

In her professional career, Enid served on the Counseling Department Advisory Board at Idaho State University, was a film producer for "Temple by the River," served as director of the ISU Family Education Counseling Center, and served as chairperson of the Licensure Committee for the Idaho American Personnel & Guidance Association. An advocate for adoption, she was a member of the Steering Committee Region X Adoption Center-Child Welfare-Seattle. Enid also worked a clinical practitioner for LDS Social Services, and a teacher in home economics, science and English.

She received a bachelor's degree in education from the University of Alberta (Canada); a master's degree in counseling from Idaho State University; and a doctorate in counseling/counselor education, with an emphasis in mental health counseling, from Idaho State University.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO – COEUR D'ALENE

Coeur d'Alene Mayor **Sandi Bloem** is the first female mayor and first three-term mayor in the city's history. A fourth generation Coeur d'Alene native, she has deep family roots in the community. She taught 4th and 6th grades in the Coeur d'Alene School District for a decade, and also worked as a leader for the U.S. Forest Service Youth Conservation Corps program. At one time, she pursued an advanced degree in educational counseling, but put those plans on hold to help run Dingle's Hardware, her family's business. She subsequently became involved in a jewelry business and has owned and operated Johannes & Company Jewelry since 1985.

Bloem is an active community member, an advocate for underserved populations, and a strong supporter of all forms of educational opportunity in the city and region. A key issue for Bloem is completing the Education Corridor along the Spokane River to link North Idaho College and Idaho public universities and to develop more transfer opportunities for local college students.

She serves on numerous boards and advisory committees in the region and the state including the Association of Idaho Cities Board; the North Idaho Mayors' Coalition; the North Idaho College Foundation Board; and the University of Idaho's Northern Idaho Advisory Board. She also chairs the Salvation Army Advisory Board, which obtained a grant to develop Coeur d'Alene's \$65 million Ray & Joan Kroc Community Center.

Bloem co-chaired the city's Downtown Revitalization Committee, chaired the city's strategic planning committee (CdA 2020), and served on the Planning Commission. She also has served on the board of directors for the Coeur d'Alene Chamber of Commerce, and the EXCEL Foundation.

Alumni Hall of Fame 2011

This award was created in 1962 and recognizes alumni who have achieved national or international distinction by their accomplishments and leadership. Consideration will be given for: distinction in career accomplishments; leadership within career organizations; voluntary leadership efforts in charitable causes; leadership efforts which have improved the cultural, social, political or economic well-being of society; prior recognition and honors; and artistic, innovative or technical accomplishments.

Professor Emeritus Richard N. Loeppky's research was instrumental in the discovery of a potent family of carcinogens in tobacco and tobacco smoke. He is internationally recognized as an expert on the chemistry of a group of cancer-causing agents called nitrosamines.

Early in his career, he elucidated the chemical reaction that creates these compounds. Later, his findings allowed other researchers to identify the health risks inherent in tobacco use and tobacco smoke, and catapulted him into cancer research.

His subsequent work has led to the elimination or significant reduction of carcinogens in cosmetics and personal care items, in metalworking fluids and in several drugs.

Loeppky, of Mukilteo, Washington, currently serves as an adviser to the European Union on the construction and revision of regulations related to nitrosamines. He is the recipient of numerous awards, including a Founders' Award from the American Chemical Society (ACS), Division of Chemical Toxicology. He is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and a fellow of the American Chemical Society.

He was awarded the Silver and Gold Outstanding Alumnus Award from the University of Idaho in 2000.

Born and raised in Lewiston, Idaho, he graduated from Lewiston High School in 1955. He earned a bachelor's degree in chemistry in 1959 from the University of Idaho and a Ph.D. in organic chemistry from the University of Michigan in 1963.

In 1964, he joined the University of Missouri Department of Chemistry, where he enjoyed a very fruitful 41-year career. Now a professor emeritus at the Missouri university, he also serves as a faculty associate in the Department of Medicinal Chemistry at the University of Washington in Seattle.

Gary Stubblefield attended the University of Idaho as a Navy ROTC student, earning a bachelor of science degree in botany in 1969. Upon graduation, he was commissioned an ensign in the U.S. Navy.

Over the course of a 21-year career, he earned numerous military honors, including the Bronze Star Medal Combat V, four Meritorious Service Medals, the Navy Commendation Medal and many service medals.

Immediately after graduation from University of Idaho, he completed arduous UDT/SEAL training. He served in many countries and regions as a member and leader of SEAL teams. His career focus was in anti-terrorism activities and underwater operations, including operating small wet submersibles, development of special diving equipment and submarine operations.

While serving, Stubblefield was selected to attend the prestigious Naval Postgraduate School, where he earned a master's degree in political science. He has served in armed combat in three theaters of war during his career.

Stubblefield retired in 1990 and now provides security management consultation and has become a leading global expert in deterring maritime piracy. Since 1994, he has co-authored books, manuscripts and manuals focused on security issues and averting terrorist activities. He is recognized as a global expert in anti- and counter-terrorism and maritime piracy, and has addressed these issues on NBC, ABC and FCN news networks.

He was in the military, he also served for two years as president of GlobalOptions, a crisis management firm headquartered in Washington, D.C., and founded Vantage Systems Incorporated, a security management firm. He helped establish and continues to assist in the U.S. Department of Energy's Global Threat Reduction Initiative, which combats radiological dispersal devices commonly called "radioactive dirty bombs."

He travels globally, initiating security enhancements to safeguard radioactive materials that are attractive to terrorists. His work has resulted in physical security upgrades to more than 250 facilities worldwide.

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator – gowns of bachelors have pointed sleeves; those of masters have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study; the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods


The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining- the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming- the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in Agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning. Colors associated with the different disciplines are as follows:

Honor Cords

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze, cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret-style soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the University's centennial year and is worn today by faculty serving as officials at the University commencements.

The mace, a heavy staff or club used in medieval times for breaking armor, acquired a ceremonial function in 13th-century France as a symbol of secular authority. The University of Idaho mace — designed by Edmund M. Chavez, professor emeritus, with metal work by Idaho artist Ray Goodner — was used for the first time at the 1989 centennial commencement. It is 32 inches long, made of walnut, and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals are set. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers.
