PRESIDENT C. SCOTT GREEN



C. Scott Green took office as the 19th president of the University of Idaho on July 1, 2019. President Green joined U of I as a highly accomplished executive with a career in global finance, operations and administration. He is also a proud alumnus of the university, graduating in 1984 with a Bachelor of Science in accounting.

Born in Moscow, Green's family moved to Boise, where he graduated from Boise High School. Following his degree from the University of Idaho, the third-generation Vandal went to work for Boise Cascade Corporation. He went on to attend Harvard Business School and received a Master of Business Administration in 1989.

Green worked for Deloitte and Touche as part of its accelerated career program from 1989-94. He then worked in banking, serving in various management roles for Goldman Sachs and ING Barings. He published two books on the Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002, which reformed regulations around auditing and financial reporting.

Green went on to leadership in global law firms, including service as CEO at Pepper Hamilton and as executive director at WilmerHale. He most recently served as the chief operating and financial officer for Hogan Lovells, one of the largest law firms in the world, with annual revenues of more than \$2 billion. Green led all of the firm's worldwide operations, technology, conflicts and finance functions. He had global responsibility for more than 3,000 employees in more than 30 countries.

The first non-lawyer to run an American Lawyer 100 law firm, Green was recognized as one of the Top 50 Big Law Innovators of the Last 50 Years by The American Lawyer magazine in 2013. A certified public accountant, Green was inducted into the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' Business and Industry Hall of Fame in 2006. He received the Institute of Internal Auditors Outstanding Contributor Award in 2004 and 2006.

Green's commitment to the University of Idaho over many years has included service on the U of I Alumni Association's national Board of Directors, the College of Business and Economics Advisory Board and on the U of I Foundation Board. He is also a Vandal Scholarship Fund supporter.

Green and his wife, Gabriella, an interior design project manager, have two adult children: Nicholas and Christina.

Anthony Doerr

Anthony Doerr was born and raised in Cleveland, Ohio. He is the author of the story collections *The Shell Collector* and *Memory Wall*, the memoir *Four Seasons in Rome*, and the novels *About Grace*, *All the Light We Cannot See*, which was awarded the 2015 Pulitzer Prize for fiction and the 2015 Andrew Carnegie Medal for Excellence in Fiction, and *Cloud Cuckoo Land*, which was a finalist for the 2021 National Book Award, a finalist for Novel of the Year in the British Book Awards, and winner of the Grand Prix de Littérature Américaine in France.

Doerr's short stories and essays have won five O. Henry Prizes and been anthologized in *The Best American Short Stories*, *New American Stories*, *The Best American Essays*, *The Scribner Anthology of Contemporary Fiction*, and many other places.

His work has been translated into over 40 different languages and won the Barnes & Noble Discover Prize, the Rome Prize, the New York Public Library's Young Lions Award, a Guggenheim Fellowship,

an NEA Fellowship, an Alex Award from the American Library Association, the National Magazine Award for Fiction, four Pushcart Prizes, three Pacific Northwest Book Awards, five Ohioana Book Awards, the 2010 Story Prize, which is considered the most prestigious prize in the U.S. for a collection of short stories, and the Sunday Times Audible Short Story Award. *All the Light We Cannot See* was a #1 *New York Times* bestseller and remained on the *New York Times* Bestseller List for over 200 weeks in hardcover.

Otis Livingston

Otis Livingston '91 is CBS New York's weekday sports anchor. The multiple Emmy Award winner has been with WCBS-TV since 2009. Otis was the host of Jets Flight Plan, a half hour show with the New York Jets Head Coach for nine seasons getting exclusive behind the scenes access with Rex Ryan and then Todd Bowles. He has also served as the sideline reporter for New York Jets pre-season games since 2010. Otis also travels with the Jets during the regular season filing exclusive one on one pre and postgame interviews for Jets Late Night, a half hour post game show. Otis has served as a sideline reporter for CBS Sports' NFL football coverage for many seasons. He was also a sideline reporter for CBS Sports' coverage of the NCAA Tournament: March Madness for three seasons.

Previously, Livingston held the position of sports anchor for NBC4's "Today in New York." He has reported on the NBA Finals, the Stanley Cup Finals, the World Series, the U.S. Open Tennis Championship, two U.S. Open Golf Championships, as well as horse racing's Triple

Crown races and the New York City Marathon. Otis also provided post game interviews and reports following the New York Giants Super Bowl wins in 2008 and 2012. He also covered the New Jersey Nets when they made NBA Finals appearances in 2002 and 2003.

In 2004, Livingston had the honor of carrying the Olympic torch through Harlem as part of the torch's world tour leading up to the Summer Olympics in Athens. Later that summer, he was a studio host and field reporter for NBC's coverage of the Athens Games and in 2006, a field reporter for the Torino Olympics. Otis also served as a sideline reporter for the New York Giants pre-season games and a studio host for NBC's national Sports Desk show.

Livingston served as the weekend sports anchor and weekday sports reporter for two years with WWOR-TV. During his tenure there, he also hosted "Sports Team Wrap-Up," a 15-minute sports extra show on Sunday nights. Two years prior to that, Livingston worked for WPHL-TV in Philadelphia as the weekend sports anchor/reporter, hosting "Sunday Sports Express," a half-hour sports wrap-up show. He covered the 76ers, Phillies, Flyers, and Eagles. He also filled in as co-host of the weekly show with Eagles Head Coach Ray Rhodes. Otis got exclusive one on one interviews with Rhodes immediately following Eagles games. Before that, Livingston was a weekend sports anchor/reporter at WTVO-TV in Rockford, Illinois, for two years.

Livingston is a member of the board of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Philadelphia chapter. He is also a board member of the New Jersey Music Workshop for the Arts. A graduate of the University of Idaho with a Bachelor of Science degree in Telecommunications, Livingston was also a member of the 1988 Kansas University basketball team that won the national title.

Livingston resides in New Jersey with his wife of more than three decades, Nikki. They are the proud parents of five beautiful children.

Karole Honas '77 Karole Honas worked in television for more than 40 years, serving as an anchor at KIFI Local News 8 for nearly 30 years. She has been inducted into the Silver Circle of the National Academy of Television, Arts, and Sciences, an award honoring dedicated broadcasters who have made significant contributions to the industry and communities in their region.

As a University of Idaho alumna, she has served as a member of U of I's Journalism and Mass Media advisory board. Throughout her career she consistently reached out to U of I students interested in television news. Honas has served as a mentor for young reporters and anchors, helping them prepare for jobs in larger media markets. She is often found interacting one-on-one with her neighbors, community leaders and local businesspersons. As a broadcaster, she was always a highly recognized individual who took time to visit with those who know her from her public broadcasting position. People looked to Honas as a respected,

leading voice to investigate and report on the important issues facing communities in eastern Idaho and western Wyoming.

Honas continues to be an active and responsible member of her community. Retired for three years, she currently serves on several boards, including Idaho Falls City Club, the Bingham Group, and spends hours at Champ's Heart.

Honas met her husband, Ken Honas, at U of I. They have been married for 47 years. They have three sons, all of whom have graduated from U of I and are gainfully employed. Go Vandals!

University of Idaho President's Medallion

The President's Medallion is presented at commencements to individuals selected by the university president who have made significant contributions to the cultural, economic, scientific and/or social advancement of Idaho and its people, as well as provided exceptional service to the state or nation that has influenced the well-being of humankind.



Jean'ne M. Shreeve

Jean'ne Shreeve is the University of Idaho Distinguished Professor of Chemistry. She is the longest serving U of I employee and over her 63 years, Dr. Shreeve rose through the academic ranks from assistant to full professor and served as chair of the Department of Chemistry and Vice President for Research and Graduate Students. In 2011, she was named a Fellow of the American Chemical Society (ACS), and in February 2024 was recognized by the Washington-Idaho Border Section (WIBS) of the ACS for 70 years of active membership in the American Chemical Society. She has served in many leadership roles in the national ACS chapter and in WIBS.

Few faculty members in the country can match Shreeve's production. She and her coworkers have published more than 725 refereed academic articles, many on the development of new syntheses of fluoronitrogen compounds. Her innovation with fluorine led to many honors, including being named an Alfred P. Sloan Foundation fellow in 1970 and the Garvan-Olin Medal from the American Chemical Society in 1972. As the aerospace industry moved away from fluorine research, Shreeve's focus shifted to working with other energetic materials over the past 20 years. Her work has been cited more than 32,000 times worldwide.

The undergraduate students, graduate students and postdoctoral fellows under Dr. Shreeve's tutelage have gone on to their own distinguished careers, working for Los Alamos National Laboratory, in the military, in academics and at companies like 3M and Allied Chemical Corporation.

What particularly sets Dr. Shreeve apart from other top scientists and faculty, is how her mentoring and personal relationships with her former students and postdoctoral researchers continue even decades after they leave her research group. Roughly every other year, the Shreeve lab alumni gather to reconnect with one another and to honor Dr. Shreeve. In 2022, she celebrated with former students Brian Hill '65, Charles 'Tom' Ratliffe '67, Richard Swindell '72, Dennis Sauer '72 and Ramesh Kumar '81, who were all inducted into the U of I Alumni Hall of Fame.

Shreeve earned her bachelor's degree at the University of Montana, her master's degree at the University of Minnesota, and her doctorate at the University of Washington.

Honorary Degree

An honorary degree is awarded to a person deserving of honor by virtue of scholarly distinction, noteworthy public service or significant contributions to the state of Idaho. In the selection of candidates for honorary degrees, preference is given to those who are Idaho residents or University of Idaho graduates.

Keiko Ogura

Keiko Ogura was born in 1937 in Hiroshima. On August 6, 1945, when Keiko was eight years old, she was exposed to the atomic bomb 2.4km away from the hypocenter. She graduated from Hiroshima Jogakuin University in 1959. In 1962, Keiko married Kaoru Ogura, who served as the director of the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum. After her husband's death in 1979, Keiko became an interpreting coordinator for peace-movement visitors from abroad. She has continued to carry out the mission to spread knowledge about the atomic bombings and keep the survivors' stories alive.

In 1984, she founded Hiroshima Interpreters for Peace (HIP) and published the Hiroshima Handbook and Hiroshima Peace Park Guide. In 2011, she was appointed as the official teller of the Hiroshima A-bomb experience in English by the Hiroshima Peace Culture Foundation. With a strong belief in conveying the reality of the atomic bombing to people around the world, she has shared her A-bomb experience with world leaders and people in more than 50 countries

and regions. She recently shared her story with world leaders attending the G7 Summit in May 2023. She also received the Chugoku Culture Award in Nov 2023.

The University of Idaho welcomed Keiko Ogura as a guest speaker for the "Remembering Hiroshima" event in 2022. One year later, five U of I students completed a project to translate Keiko's children's story. The story, along with the English translation, will be published in Japan as a kamishibai, a traditional method to tell children's stories using large boards with pictures on one side and text on the other. The students visited Japan to meet Keiko and present the kamishibai to her at Hiroshima University.

In recognition of her vast contributions to worldwide peace, education and relationship building with the University of Idaho community, the University of Idaho is proud to bestow upon Keiko Ogura, the honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree as part of the Spring 2024 commencement ceremonies.



Idaho's WWAMI Medical Education Program is a partnership with the University of Washington School of Medicine and the states of Washington, Wyoming, Alaska, Montana, and Idaho. Started in 1972, WWAMI is currently in its 52nd year of successfully educating Idaho's physicians. The WWAMI program is nationally accredited through its partnership with the UW School of Medicine, allowing 40 Idaho medical students to complete their first 18 months of medical training at the University of Idaho, Moscow campus. Idaho's medical students complete the remainder of their clinical training in Idaho through the WWAMI clinical site in Boise and throughout the five-state WWAMI region.

SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC APPAREL AND SYMBOLS OF INVESTITURE

University of Idaho Academic Mace

Maces date to the Middle Ages and symbolize strength and authority. Each is unique and reflects the values and characteristics of the institution. The university's chief marshal, who leads all academic processions, carries the mace.

The University of Idaho's mace, used for the first time at the centennial commencement, is 32 inches long, made of walnut and encircled with bands of Idaho gold and silver in which Idaho garnets and opals have been inlaid. The head is embellished with silver and gold representations of camas plants and syringa flowers. The chair of the university's Faculty Senate, the marshal of the academic procession, carries the mace in the American tradition, at a 45-degree angle across the chest, while in England, the bearer carries it over the shoulder.

University of Idaho President's Medallions

The first medallion was created by Idaho artists George and Macky Roberts. The President's Medallion was first used in 1965 at the inauguration of Ernest Hartung, the University of Idaho's 12th president.

The medallion's base is a three-and-a-half-inch disc of pure Idaho silver. Mounted on the base is a disc of native jasper; a sterling silver sunburst is inlaid in the disc. Inside the sunburst is a modification of the Chinese character meaning "mountain," which features three upward-pointing prongs. Over the center prong is a gold inlay, thus symbolizing "Light on the Mountain."

The heavy medallion was worn suspended from a collar woven of Idaho wool, some of which is dyed with dahlia flowers to match the jasper and some of which is from a black sheep.

The second President's Medallion, worn during commencement by then-President Timothy P. White, was commissioned in 2004. This medallion's base is a gold-leafed university seal and is worn suspended by a chain with gold leaf charms, each representing the presidents who have served the university.

SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC APPAREL AND SYMBOLS OF INVESTITURE

University of Idaho Academic Apparel

By observing certain features of the academic apparel, it is possible to learn several things about the academic status of the scholar: the level of the degree attained, the branch of learning in which it was earned, and the college or university conferring the degree.

Gowns

The gowns differ according to the level of the degree. The sleeves are the principal indicator — gowns of bachelors' have pointed sleeves; those of masters' have oblong sleeves with an arc cut away at the front; and doctors have round, bell-shaped sleeves. Bachelor's and master's gowns are untrimmed. Doctoral gowns have distinctive velvet facing down the front and three velvet bars on each sleeve.

The University of Idaho adopted a doctoral gown of its own in 1989. The silver gown has a panel and sleeve bars of black velvet outlined in antique gold. The beret-styled soft cap is patterned after the Cambridge version instead of the traditional Oxford-style mortarboard. The cap and gown were designed by Emeritus Professor Edmund Chavez in the university's centennial year and are worn today by officials and university administration.

Honor Cords

Honor Cords, worn around the neck and hanging loosely down the front, identify students who are graduating with honors: gold, summa cum laude (with highest distinction); silver, magna cum laude (with great distinction); and bronze, cum laude (with distinction). The cords are provided by the University of Idaho and are worn on this one occasion only.


Caps

The color of the tassel worn on the cap varies with the level of degree. The bachelor's tassel represents the color appropriate to the major field of study (see colors at right); the master's and specialist's tassels are black; and the doctoral tassels are old gold.

Hoods

The length of the hood also varies according to the level of degree. The bachelor's gown is worn without a hood. A master's hood is three and one-half feet long, and a doctor's hood is four feet in length and has panels at the sides. It is from the colors adorning the hood that one can learn two other facts. Lining: the hood is lined with the official color or colors of the college or university conferring the degree (silver and gold, signifying the University of Idaho). Trimming: the hood is trimmed with velvet of a color appropriate to the wearer's branch of learning. For example, the trimming for the degree of Master of Science in agriculture is maize, representing agriculture, rather than golden yellow, representing science. (In the case of the Doctor of Philosophy degree, the dark blue color is used, representing the mastery of the discipline of learning and scholarship, regardless of the branch of learning.) Colors associated with the different disciplines are listed below:

University of Idaho Boise

Premier Graduate, Research and Professional Development

University of Idaho Boise originated in 1910 when an Agricultural extension program was established in Ada County. In 1953, U of I Boise grew with the introduction of teacher education programs, which were expanded in the early 1980s. A cooperative agreement between the university and the Idaho Department of Fish and Game led to the 1963 opening of the Idaho Water Resources Research Institute (IWRRI) with offices in Boise, Moscow and Idaho Falls. Engineering courses were first delivered in Boise in 1988. Agricultural Extension, regional and state personnel, and several university support offices were located in Boise for greater statewide access and service in the early 1990s. In the late 1990s, Idaho WWAMI opened its doors in Boise and all U of I programmatic, advancement, athletics and other efforts in the community were brought together under the umbrella of U of I Boise. In the early 2000s, the College of Art and Architecture began offering courses in Boise, now including the first two years of its bachelor's degree in architecture. At the same time, the College of Law started offering externship opportunities and is now offering its complete Juris Doctor curriculum in Boise.

The College of Law moved into its permanent Boise-based facility at 501 W. Front Street in 2021 just a few blocks west of the main U of I Boise campus located at the corner of Broadway and Front. These facilities serve the greater southwest Idaho community by providing classroom space, housing U of I programs, and by hosting events and meetings for diverse groups of external stakeholders.

Today, students, faculty, researchers and staff work on a variety of topics that include water; natural resources and the environment; education; law; community sustainability and design; family economics; childhood education; pesticide safety and management; food technology, safety and processing; water resources engineering; and public policy.

Excellence at U of I Boise can be measured by the success of the many people we serve across the region and by the quality and achievements of our more than 200 faculty and staff members.

U of I Boise provides southwest Idaho access to all university resources. The center is focused on community impact, regional economic development and supporting university growth.

Strategically located in Boise – the economic and governmental center of Idaho and home to more than 55 percent of the state's population and business entities – U of I Boise supports teaching, learning, research, medical education and outreach. U of I Boise distinguishes itself through:

The University of Idaho Coeur d'Alene (U of I Coeur d'Alene) engages university expertise to transform education, develop innovative research, and cultivate a knowledge-based economy throughout North Idaho. Students achieve higher education excellence in Coeur d'Alene through in-person and distance degree programs led by faculty from across the state. More than 30 degrees and programs are available to students who wish to attend the University of Idaho from Coeur d'Alene. A variety of professional development offerings bring continuing education opportunities to professionals in both the public and private sector. Each year programs, including 4-H, Master Gardener, and the Idaho Building Capacity project, serve hundreds of community members. The University of Idaho Coeur d'Alene provides opportunities for all people in North Idaho through its degree programs, technology and research centers, outreach, and collaborative philosophy.

Technological innovation is carving a prominent place into the future of North Idaho. U of I Coeur d'Alene elevates this emerging sector with education opportunities in technology. The College of Engineering at the University of Idaho offers computer science education that is critical for satisfying workforce needs, meeting student demand, and growing the economy in North Idaho. Faculty and students in the Vandal Manufacturing Automation Laboratory support local industry by providing curriculum designed to address industry needs. The recent additions of live lab courses in both the B.S. Medical Sciences and B.S. Industrial Technology degrees bring even more educational opportunities to the area. Through collaboration on The Confluence Project, IWRRI at the U of I and fellow regional partners give hundreds of high school students hands-on water science experience from the shores of Coeur d'Alene Lake and the slopes of Lookout Pass. IWRRI also provides lake ambassador training through Bay Watchers, leads community conversations with the Our Gem Collaborative, and educates construction workers on stormwater and erosion control (Panhandle Stormwater and Erosion Education Program).

U of I Coeur d'Alene operates several facilities in the North Idaho region. The Harbor Center in Coeur d'Alene houses classrooms, conference rooms, labs, and offices. The Hedlund Building at North Idaho College (NIC) houses the Computer Science program: classrooms, robotics labs, and offices. The DeArmond Higher Education Center at NIC brings state-of-the-art student services and classroom instruction from several higher education institutions under one roof. In Post Falls, the University of Idaho Jacklin Science and Technology Center supports startup companies, U of I research projects, and U of I Extension in Kootenai County.

Through its degree programs, technology and research centers, and collaborative philosophy, University of Idaho Coeur d'Alene provides opportunity and outreach for all people of North Idaho.
