SIGNIFICANCE OF ACADEMIC COSTUMES is determined especially by the sleeves and hoods. Doctors wear the round, bell sleeve; the gown is faced down the front and barred on the sleeves with black velvet or velvet of color indicating the degree; the doctor's hood is large. The doctor may, if he so choose, wear the gold tassel on his cap. Masters wear the long, closed sleeve, with a slit near the upper part for the arm; the master's hood is of more moderate size. Bachellors wear the long, pointed sleeve; the hood is small. Undergraduates wear the round or pointed sleeve, and wear no hood. Hoods are lined with the colors of the institution granting the degree, or with which the wearer is connected, and are trimmed with velvet of the color distinctive of the degree—for example, arts and letters, white; theology, scarlet; law, purple; philosophy, blue; science, golden yellow;! fine arts, brown; medicine, green; music, pink; commerce, drab; physical education, sage green; public health, salmon pink; engineering, orange; pharmacy, olive green; dentistry, lilac; veterinary science, gray; forestry, russet; library science, lemon; pedagogy, light blue; oratory, silver gray; humanics, crimson; agriculture, maize; economics, copper.
