AWARDS

AMERICAN HISTORY ESSAY CONTEST—Scoring five points, Hays Hall placed first among campus groups in the eighteenth annual contest sponsored by the Sons of the American Revolution, thereby winning possession for the coming year of a bust of Washington designed by Bianchini. A silver medal is awarded to George T. Mouchet of Mullan for his essay, "Samuel Adams, The Voice of the Revolution." Second prize, also a silver medal, is awarded to Catherine Stover of Boise for her essay, "A Glimpse of Mt. Vernon." A silver medal is awarded as third prize to Elaine Woofter of Spokane, Washington, for her essay, "Paul Revere, Patriot."

THE PHILO SHERMAN BENNETT PRIZE is awarded annually for the best essay on a subject dealing with "The Principles of Free Government." For the year 1940-41 first prize of \$15 is awarded to George A. Poulos of Cascade for his essay on "An Analysis of the Federal Government's Agencies For Conciliation and Mediation in Labor Disputes," and second prize of \$10 to Marian Kilbourn of Gooding for her essay on "An Analysis of the Federal Government's Agencies For Conciliation and Mediation in Labor Disputes."

CIVIL ENGINEERING—Junior membership in the American Society of Civil Engineers is awarded to Francis H. Shadel of Samuels for his professional paper, "Factors Determining Airport Size and Site Location," in the annual contest sponsored by the Spokane section of the society.
