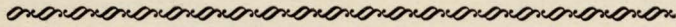

Awards

AMERICAN HISTORY ESSAY CONTEST—

Lindley Hall placed first among campus groups in the twenty-second annual contest sponsored by the Sons of the American Revolution to win possession for the coming year of a bust of Washington designed by Bianchini. For his essay, "The Forgotten Founding Father: Thomas Paine," Edmond C. Phoenix, Jerome, is awarded a silver medal as first prize. Madgdalyne M. Emerson, Caldwell, is awarded second prize, also a silver medal, for her essay, "The Life of Daniel Boone, Pioneer of Pioneers." Winner of third prize, Margaret E. Madison, Hamer, is awarded a silver medal for her essay, "John Andre."

THE PHILO SHERMAN BENNETT PRIZE—

Awarded annually for the best essays on a subject dealing with "The Principles of Free Government." For the year 1945-46 the first prize of \$15 is awarded to John Carl Krass of Harlem, Montana, for his essay on "Adjustments of United States Foreign Policy to Meet Her Membership in the United Nations Organization." Second prize of \$10 is awarded to Nancy Furey of Boise for her essay on "Recent Developments in the Full Faith and Credit Clause."
