Significance of Academic Costume

DOCTORS wear the round, bell sleeve; the gown is faced down the front and barred on the sleeves with black velvet or velvet of color indicating the degree; the doctor's hood is large. The doctor may, if he so chooses, wear the gold tassel on his cap.

MASTERS wear the long, closed sleeve, with a slit near the upper part for the arm; the master's hood is of more moderate size.

BACHELORS wear the long pointed sleeve; the hood is small.

UNDERGRADUATES wear the round or pointed sleeve, and wear no hood.

Hoods are lined with the colors of the institutions granting the degree, or with which the wearer is connected, and are trimmed with velvet of the color distinctive of the degree — for example, arts and letters, white; philosophy, blue; science, gold-yellow; music, pink; agriculture, maize; engineering, orange; forestry, russet; pedagogy, light blue; commerce and accounting, drab.

HONOR CORDS draped over the shoulders designate the students who are graduating with honors; cum laude with silver cords and summa cum laude with gold cords. These are recognition cords and are worn on this one occasion only — they are not part of the academic costume.

Honor Cords are provided by the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi.

Citations of Merit Upon Retirement

Alvin R. Aller, Associate Professor Emeritus of Botany

Prior to his appointment to the University of Idaho faculty, Dr. Aller was a visiting professor here from 1959 to 1961. His previous teaching experiences included several years at Northwest Nazarene College, Nampa, where he was chairman of the biology department and head of the division of natural sciences and mathematics. A graduate of Bethany College and recipient of a master's degree from Kansas State University, both in his home state of Kansas, Dr. Aller earned his doctorate at Oregon State University. He is the author of several publications in his field and is active professionally in the Ecological Society of America, the American Society of Plant Taxonomists, American Nature Study Society, Northwest Scientific Association and the American Association for the Advancement of Science. He was elected to Gamma Sigma Delta, Phi Sigma (in which he has been active as council representative for the local chapter), Sigma Xi, Phi Kappa Phi, American Men of Science and Who's Who in American Education.

**Nancy I. Atkinson, Catalog Librarian Emerita with the
equivalent rank of Professor (Head, Catalog Department
1943-72)**

Miss Atkinson joined the Idaho library staff as catalog librarian after having held positions in the Detroit, Michigan, Public Library and at the Eastern Michigan University Library. She attended Mills College and received a bachelor of arts degree from the University of Michigan, and later, a degree in library science from the same university. In 1965, Miss Atkinson took a sabbatical leave from her duties at Idaho to survey technical services organization in South American, Australian and New Zealand libraries. Active in several professional organizations, Miss Atkinson is a member of the American Library Association;

the Pacific Northwest Library Association which she served as secretary, vice chairman and chairman of the technical services division; Idaho Library Association; Phi Kappa Phi, and Phi Beta Kappa, which she served as secretary, vice president and president of the Idaho chapter.

**William H. Baker, Professor Emeritus of Botany (Head,
Department of Biological Sciences 1956-67)**

Even before his appointment as assistant professor on the University of Idaho faculty in 1948, Dr. Baker had focused his professional interests on the plant life of the Northwest. A native of Portland, Oregon, he was graduated from Oregon College of Education, then received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Oregon State University. He attended the Naval Training School (Communications) at Harvard University, the Oceanographic Laboratories of the University of Washington and the Oregon Institute of Marine Biology. After serving as a naval officer in World War II, he received his doctorate from Oregon State University. During his years of service on the Idaho faculty, Dr. Baker was acting head of the Department of Biological Sciences and became its head in 1956. He is the author of numerous publications on plant life of the Northwest, with research projects including studies of the plants of Oregon Caves National Monument, Crater Lake National Park, Tomer's Butte in Latah County and Craters of the Moon National Monument. He was appointed a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. Dr. Baker's professional societies include membership in the International Society of Plant Taxonomists, International Organization of Plant Biosystemists, American Botanical Society, American Fern Society, American Association of University Professors, Northwest Scientific Association (president, 1962), Idaho Academy of Science (president, 1959-60), American Institute of Biological Sciences, Phi Sigma and Sigma Xi (Idaho Chapter president, 1955-56).

Lalia P. Boone, Professor Emerita of English (Linguistics)

A member of the University of Idaho faculty since 1965, Dr. Boone came to the Northwest from the University of Florida, where she had advanced from the rank of instructor to associate professor. She received her bachelor of arts degree from East Texas State College, her master of science degree from the University of Oklahoma and her doctorate from the University of Florida. Though her specialty has been middle English, Dr. Boone is credited with having a deep background in folklore, linguistics and technical writing. In 1966 she began the "Idaho Place Names Project" as a personal hobby. The project, aimed at compilation of a state place names dictionary, now has funding from outside agencies and is one of two pilot projects in a nationwide survey. Dr. Boone was also active in helping organize the Idaho Council of Teachers of English which she served as president, and later, as coordinator between the state section and the national organization. In connection with the council she conducted numerous workshops for English teachers around the state. Dr. Boone's membership in professional organizations includes vice presidency of the American Name Society, and membership in American Dialect Society; American Association of University Professors; American Association Of University Women; Florida Council, Teachers of English; Delta Phi Alpha; National Council of Teachers of English; Modern Language Association; National League of American Pen Women; South Atlantic MLA, and Phi Lambda Theta.

**Helen H. Cunningham, Assistant Research Professor
Emerita of Home Economics Research**

A Moscow native, Mrs. Cunningham earned her bachelor's degree from the University of Idaho and her master's degree from Iowa State University. She has taught in the schools of Malad, Rupert and Moscow and at Iowa State University and Oregon State University. In 1935 she spent a brief time as acting teacher trainer and state supervisor (home economics education) on the Moscow campus. Her first regular faculty appointment came in 1940, when she was assigned the position of Assistant Professor of Home Economics and Assistant State Supervisor. In 1943 she taught the nursery school demonstration class at the university. During the fifties, Mrs. Cunningham worked temporarily as research assistant and in 1961 was appointed to the faculty on a part time basis. In 1966 she increased her teaching load. Mrs. Cunningham holds membership in various organizations, among them the American Home Economics Association; Idaho Home Economics Association; Phi Upsilon Omicron; Omicron Nu; American Association of University Women, and Phi Kappa Phi.

**Cedric G. d'Easum, Associate Extension Professor and
Extension Editor Emeritus**

Mr. d'Easum, a Boise resident, accepted the post of assistant extension editor with the University of Idaho in

1949. Born at Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta, Canada, he was graduated from Rupert, Idaho schools and continued study at Idaho Technical Institute in Pocatello. He received some of his earliest journalistic training on the University of Idaho's **Argonaut**. After receiving a bachelor's degree from the university, Mr. d'Easum was on the editorial staffs of the Spokane Chronicle and the Times-Register, Idaho Falls, followed by 10 years as a reporter and feature writer for the Idaho Daily Statesman in Boise. Before coming to the university staff, Mr. d'Easum spent several years as a public relations officer with the State Fish and Game Department. During the years with the university, he worked out of Boise, rising to the position of associate extension professor and extension editor.

**Carolyn A. Folz, Law Librarian Emerita with the
equivalent rank of Associate Professor**

Mrs. Folz, a native of Evansville, Indiana, first came to the University of Idaho in 1945 as a law librarian. A liberal arts graduate of Evansville College, Mrs. Folz also received a bachelor of science degree in library science from the University of Illinois. She later earned a master of arts degree at the University of Idaho. Prior to her many years of service to the law school, Mrs. Folz had extensive experience with the Library of Congress, the University of Illinois Library and the Evansville Public Library. Her continuous service has been a sizeable contribution to the College of Law during its many years of steady growth in restrictive facilities.

**Dr. William E. Folz, Professor of Agricultural Economics
and Department Head Emeritus (Head, Department of
Agricultural Economics, 1962-71)**

A widely known authority on farm marketing, Dr. Folz has been a member of the University of Idaho Agricultural Economics faculty since 1935. In 1963 he was on leave from the university, serving as consultant of marketing research at the Agricultural Institute, Dublin, Ireland. During World War II, on leave from the university, he served on the Senate Small Business Committee as fiscal economist; on the Bureau of the Budget, 1943-44; and as Associate Chief of the Food Price Division, Office of Price Administration, 1944-45. Dr. Folz has been an economic consultant to the Bureau of Reclamation and to the Fiscal Policy Committee of Governor Jordan; Chairman of the Western Agricultural Economic Research Council, 1953-55; president of the Western Farm Economic Association, 1962, special consultant on marketing, U.S.D.A. Agricultural Marketing Service, 1957-58, and director of the American Farm Economic Association, 1962. A member of numerous American scholarly and professional associations, he is also a fellow of the Royal Economic Association, Great Britain, and an honorary member of the Agricultural Science Association, Dublin, Ireland. A graduate of Evansville College, Dr. Folz received both his master's and doctoral degrees from the

University of Illinois. He is the author of several publications dealing with the income structure of the state and economics of water resources development.

**Allen S. Janssen, Professor of Civil Engineering and
Dean Emeritus (Dean and Director, College of
Engineering and Engineering Experiment Station,
1946-67)**

Professor Janssen joined the university faculty in 1931 as an instructor in civil engineering. He was a testing engineer and instructor from 1936-39; testing engineer and assistant professor, 1939-42, and on military leave as associate professor and acting head of civil engineering 1942-46. During the 21 years between 1946-67, the Boise native served the College of Engineering as its dean, leading it through the turbulent post World War II and space era when the profession and practice of engineering expanded into its present form. Until his retirement, Professor Janssen served as professor of civil engineering. He has worked for the Idaho department of highways and as district engineer with the Wheat Section, Agricultural Adjustment Administration. He has been active in numerous scientific and professional organizations both on the local and national levels. In 1956, he received recognition from the national Council of Engineering Examiners for his outstanding service to the engineering profession.

**James E. Kraus, Professor of Plant Sciences and Dean
Emeritus (Dean and Director, College of Agriculture,
Agricultural Experiment Station and Cooperative
Extension Service, 1955-72)**

Dean Kraus retires with a highly commendable record of service to the University of Idaho. His first university assignment in 1941 was as associate horticulturist at the Aberdeen Experiment Station. In 1945, he became associate professor of horticulture and associate horticulturist at the Moscow experiment station, rising to professor and head of the department of horticulture in 1948. Two years later, Professor Kraus was named associate director of the Agricultural Experiment Station. With the appointment of Donald R. Theophilus to the university presidency, Professor Kraus was selected to be his successor as Dean of the College of Agriculture in 1955. Since then, Dean Kraus has won the respect of his colleagues by the integrity and sincerity of his administration. Dean Kraus' research activities included sabbatical leave in California in 1960, where he surveyed Idaho potatoes and potato products in wholesale and retail establishments, visited vegetable seed companies and breeding farms, and investigated agricultural programs in universities and experiment stations. A native of Swink, Colorado, Dean Kraus received his bachelor's degree from Colorado State University, his master's from the University of Wisconsin and his doctorate from Cornell University. For five years prior to joining the university faculty, he was assistant physiologist of the horticultural field station at Cheyenne, Wyoming.

**Austin Maurice Lashbrook, Professor Emeritus of
Foreign Languages (Classics)**

Dr. Lashbrook arrived at the University of Idaho in 1967 as a visiting professor from the University of Kansas, where he had been professor and chairman of the department of classics and classical archeology. Throughout his career he has held various teaching positions in Illinois, South Carolina, Georgia, Iowa, Pennsylvania, Massachusetts, Tennessee and summer appointments in Kentucky and Alberta, Canada. Born and raised in Daviess County, Kentucky, Dr. Lashbrook was graduated from Western Kentucky State Teacher's College and received a master's degree from the University of Kentucky. He was awarded the doctorate from the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Lashbrook has served as national vice president of the American Classical League and is a member of the Classical Association of the Middle West and South; the American Philological Association; American Association of University Professors, and Phi Delta Kappa. He is also the author of several research articles in his field.

**A. Norman Nybrotten, Professor Emeritus of Economics
(Associate Director, Bureau of Business and Economic
Research, 1958 - 1972)**

Dr. Nybrotten began service to the University of Idaho in 1939 as an assistant professor of agricultural economics, advancing to associate professor in 1944. He received both his bachelor's and doctoral degrees at the University of Wisconsin, in his native state. During World War II, Dr. Nybrotten taught army engineers on campus and served on the War Labor Board and War Food Administration. In addition to work on several research projects, he served as consultant to the Bureau of Reclamation and the National Resources Planning Board. In 1948, he left the university to serve as professor of agricultural economics at West Virginia University and project director for twelve Northeastern states in poultry and egg marketing research. Ten years later, Dr. Nybrotten returned to Idaho as professor of economics and later, he was named associate director of the newly created Bureau of Business and Economic Research. In these positions he has conducted research on various aspects of the Idaho economy, including Indian affairs, highway economics, credit and economic development. He has also served as consultant for private developers and the State of Washington Natural Resources Board. In 1968, he was the U.S. representative on a United Nations economic mission to Thailand. The author of two books, one of which is the **Idaho Statistical Abstract**, Dr. Nybrotten has also published many research reports and articles. He served as editor of the **Idaho Business and Economics Review**.

**Louise Laybourn Slade, Catalog Librarian Emerita with
the equivalent rank of Associate Professor**

Mrs. Slade's first appointment at the University of Idaho was in 1944 when she joined the library staff as periodicals

assistant. She left in 1948 to work at the University of Oregon Library until marriage brought her back to Moscow a year later. She was rehired as library assistant and became serials librarian the following year. In 1969, Mrs. Slade was appointed catalog librarian. A native of Cope, Colorado, Mrs. Slade received both a bachelor of arts and a bachelor of science degree (library science) from the University of Denver.

**Joseph W. Watts, Business Manager and Bursar
Emeritus (Business Manager 1961-71; Bursar 1967-71)**

Mr. Watts began his professional career at the University of Idaho in 1940 after graduating from the university's College of Business Administration. The Kendrick native accepted a position as assistant accountant, later becoming budget officer, assistant business manager and business manager and bursar. In the position of bursar, the designated business agent of the Board of Regents, Mr. Watts served in a dual role for the university. He was elevated to that position in 1967 when Financial Vice President Kenneth A. Dick retired. Serving under presidents Dale, Buchanan, Theophilus and Hartung, Mr. Watts was instrumental in establishing many current business office procedures. In addition, he is credited with designing and implementing the funding methods used in financing the major buildings constructed on the Idaho campus in recent years.

**Ralph Martin Wise, Associate Research Professor
Emeritus of Agricultural Biochemistry**

Mr. Wise has made a large contribution to the State of Idaho and the entire nation with his wheat quality research. Since he joined the University of Idaho staff in 1960, he has been associated with the Aberdeen Branch Experiment Station. Previous to that, the Kansas native worked as chief chemist on product control and wheat quality research in flour mills. He is a graduate of McPherson College. The author of numerous articles and reports dealing with his research activities, Mr. Wise has recently been working on a project, "Studies of Factors Affecting the Quality of Idaho Wheat." In the past his research work included an assignment for the Bolivian Government in wheat research of their flour mills, bakeries and experiment stations. A member of the American Association of Cereal Chemists, he has been secretary, vice president and president of the Pacific Northwest Section of that association.

**Albert E. Whitehead, Professor Emeritus of Speech
(Chairman, Speech, 1947-72)**

After graduation from the University of Colorado and upon receipt of a master's degree from the University of Wisconsin, Professor Whitehead began service to the

University of Idaho in 1930 as instructor in public speaking. He later earned his doctorate from the University of Wisconsin. During his career Dr. Whitehead took sabbatical leave in 1967 to study the phonetics program at the University of London and public speaking and debate at that university and at Oxford University. He has published articles on the oratory of William Edgar Borah. A member of the American Association of University Professors, and the Idaho Speech Association, he was a delegate to the 1958 Legislative Assembly of the Speech Association of America; commissioner-at-large for Idaho for the Western Speech Association and chairman of its Idaho membership committee, and secretary-treasurer and vice president of the Pacific Forensic League.

**Ernest W. Wohletz, Professor of Forestry and Dean
Emeritus (Dean and Director, College of Forestry,
Wildlife and Range Sciences and Forest, Wildlife and
Range Experiment Station, 1953-71).**

Of the four deans in the College of Forestry's history, Professor Wohletz filled the appointment the longest. He guided its growth since he became dean of the college and director of the Forestry, Wildlife and Range Sciences Experiment Station in 1953. During these years, the college has expanded its programs in outdoor recreation and watershed management, increased faculty 300 percent, and added doctoral degree programs in several areas. The college also added a federally supported Idaho Cooperative Fishery Unit and an Idaho Cooperative Wildlife Research Unit and was instrumental in obtaining a Wilderness Research Center in the Idaho Primitive Area. Professor Wohletz' career culminated in the completion of the new Forestry Building in 1971, the year he stepped down from the deanship to return to teaching. He played a key role in obtaining the authorization and funds for construction. Professor Wohletz earned his bachelor's and master's degrees and completed doctoral work at the University of California at Berkeley. During the early 1930's, he worked in the research branch of the U.S. Forest Service and later was an instructor in the School of Forestry at Berkeley. He first came to the University of Idaho in 1937 as assistant professor. His leadership was quickly felt by the college, as a year later, he created the forestry summer camp, now in its 34th session. In addition to publication of numerous scientific papers, Professor Wohletz has been director of a national forage resources survey under the Public Land Law Review Commission in 1971; an advisor to Idaho's governor; a member of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce Natural Resources Committee and more recently on the Western States Land Use Committee. In 1964 he was elected to represent the Western States as an advisor to the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture. He has been active in numerous professional organizations.
