


Citations of Merit Upon Retirement

Florence D. Aller, Professor of Home Economics and Department Head Emerita

Dr. Aller has been an educator for more than 40 years and has taught at almost every level of education. Since joining the University staff full time in 1962, Dr. Aller has been acting head of the home economics department twice and has served as department head since 1971. Before joining the University faculty, she taught at Washington State University, Northwest Nazarene College, Oregon State University, a junior college, a high school and a grade school. She has a bachelor's degree from Bethany-Penial College in Oklahoma, a master's degree in home economics from Oregon State College and an Ed.D. from the University of Idaho in guidance and counseling. She has published a number of articles and has presented professional papers at national and international conferences. Among other awards and honors, she was selected to serve as the U.S.A. delegate to the IIIrd International Conference, World Union of Organizations for the Safeguard of Youth in Evian, France, representing the National Council on Family Relations in 1966. She has been listed in Who's Who in the West, the Dictionary of International Biography, Who's Who Among American Women and the Royal Blue Book of England. She is a member of many professional and scholarly organizations including the Idaho Home Economics Association in which she has held several offices. She is currently on the Board of Directors of the National Council on Family Relations and is president of the Idaho Council on Family Relations. She has served as a curriculum consultant and guest speaker for a large number of organizations and agencies.

William B. Ardrey, Professor of Veterinary Science and Veterinary Microbiologist Emeritus

A native of Denver, Colorado, Dr. Ardrey came to the University of Idaho in 1939 as assistant bacteriologist soon after receiving his Ph.D. in bacteriology from Michigan State. He also has a master's degree in bacteriology from Michigan and a bachelor's degree in biology from Monmouth (III.) College. Dr. Ardrey has been engaged in research with major emphasis on reproductive diseases of livestock, reproductive performance in beef cattle and bluebag in ewes. His University responsibilities included teaching and advising graduate students. Dr. Ardrey is author or co-author of more than a dozen scientific articles and publications. He is among those named in American Men of Science, Who's Who in the West and Who's Who in America.

John L. Barnhart, Professor Emeritus of Food Science

Dr. Barnhart first joined the University staff in 1934 as an assistant professor of dairy science. He left after only one year, but returned 23 years later and has since given 17 years of service to the University of Idaho. Dr. Barnhart is a native of Pennsylvania and received both his bachelor's degree and his Ph.D. from Pennsylvania State University. He also holds a master of science degree from West Virginia University. He has studied at Princeton University, the University of New Mexico and Temple University Law School. While at Temple, he was director of science and chairman of the Dairy Technology Department. Dr. Barnhart has also served as dean of the College of Agriculture and dean of faculty at Delaware Valley College of

Agriculture and Science. He has held appointments as associate professor of dairy science at Kansas State University and Oklahoma A&M. As an Air Force reservist from 1950-68, he was director of research and development of the 6570th Aerospace Medical Research Laboratory at Wright Patterson Air Force Base in Ohio. He retired from the reserves as a colonel. For a time Dr. Barnhart was engaged in the dairy products business in Washington, D.C., and Baltimore, Maryland, including ownership and operation of ice cream plants. Scientific work in which he is or has been engaged includes dairy manufacturing, dairy products, and freeze-dried food products. He received the Meritorious Award from the Idaho Milk Processors Association in 1962 for service to the State of Idaho. He also was awarded the Air Force Commendation Medal.

Mark B. Calnon, Extension Professor Emeritus

Professor Calnon spent his entire University of Idaho Cooperative Extension career in Ada County. He was appointed extension agricultural agent for that county in 1945. He received his bachelor's degree in animal husbandry from the University of Idaho in 1940. Professor Calnon, well known for his strong 4-H program, was recognized for that work in 1960 when the National County Agents Association presented him the Distinguished Service Award. He is past president of the Idaho County Agents Association and has also served as president of the Idaho chapter of Epsilon Sigma Phi, extension honorary society. From 1941-45 he served in the military as a B-17 pilot. His military service included 19 months as a prisoner of war in Germany.

Russell L. Chrysler, Professor of Marketing and Department Chairman Emeritu

In 1959, Dr. Chrysler came to the University of Idaho as professor of marketing with a broad background of teaching experience. A native of Minnesota, he received his bachelor of business administration and his master's degrees from the University of Minnesota in 1932 and 1937 respectively. He earned his Ph.D at Northwestern University in 1953. He began his teaching career at North Dakota State College in 1937, then moved to the University of Cincinnati in 1940. Before joining the University faculty in 1959, he taught at Los Angeles State College in Los Angeles, California, Dr. Chrysler served as chairman of the University of Idaho Department of Business from 1969-73. He is a member of the American Marketing Association and has held chapter offices in that organization. He is also a member of Beta Gamma Sigma and was chapter secretary of that organization 1931-32. He also served as district director of Alpha Kappa Psi from 1966-70. He has had numerous publications and acted as president of the Northwest Universities Business Administration Conference in 1960. Active in the community, he is past president of the Moscow United Fund and is a member of the Moscow Chamber of Commerce.

George W. Cleveland, Extension Professor and Extension Dairyman Emeritus

Professor Cleveland first joined the University of Idaho cooperative extension service in 1934 and for the next 12

years was agricultural agent in Caribou, Madison and Cassia Counties. He interrupted his University service to engage in a purebred dairy operation at Gooding. In 1951 he disposed of his interest in the dairy and returned to University employment as assistant superintendent of the University's Caldwell Branch Experiment Station. In addition to administrative duties, he did dairy research work. In 1957 he accepted a position as eastern Idaho agricultural representative with the First Security Bank system. Four years later he returned to the University as extension dairyman. Professor Cleveland has written many articles and booklets on dairy subjects such as mastitis control, milking management and raising calves. Included in his work is the revision of 4-H dairy publications used in Idaho, Washington and Oregon. Professor Cleveland was elected to the Idaho Dairy Hall of Fame by the Idaho Purebred Dairy Cattle Association because of his contributions to the overall Idaho dairy industry. He served as president of the Idaho State Fair and Rodeo Association for 18 years. Professor Cleveland holds a bachelor's degree from Utah State

Alfred C. Dunn, Professor of Art Emeritus

A 1936 graduate of the University of Idaho, Alf Dunn returned to the university in 1941 to begin 33 years of teaching and artistic service. For some 20 years, he taught graphic design and watercolor and assisted Rafe Gibbs, long-time head of the University publications department, Professor Dunn has designed many university publications and also designed and illustrated "Beacon for Mountain and Plain," the history of the University of Idaho. Dunn specialized in watercolor as his major artistic medium because it allowed him to finish an individual painting quickly. He has done thousands of paintings which are now scattered all over the United States. Two of his paintings have hung in the Idaho governor's office. Idaho has been a favorite subject for the artist and some years ago he received an award from then Gov. Robert E Smylie for the large number of his watercolors which had appeared in national publications, helping promote the state. Professor Dunn with another colleague in the art department developed the university's traveling summer art class, Workshop on Wheels, which has given artists from all over the nation the opportunity to paint Idaho scenes while receiving professional instruction. Professor Dunn also holds a master of fine arts degree from California College Arts and Crafts. He has averaged two one-man shows per year for the past ten years and is currently designing and illustrating the history of Idaho in collaboration with the author.

DeLance F. Franklin, Research Professor Emeritus of Horticulture

Professor Franklin had a lengthy association with the University even before his appointment to the University faculty in 1942. He is an alumnus of the University with both bachelor's and master's degrees in horticulture. He has been superintendent of the Parma Research and Extension Center since his original appointment. In addition to his administrative duties as center superintendent, he has been active in research work. A highlight of this research was development of apple tree

blossom thinning sprays, a practice now used worldwide. He is also known for his research in vegetable seed production. During the summer of 1973. Franklin was a consultant in Egypt for the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations. His work involved a study of onion breeding, production and marketing in the country as well as development of a comprehensive plan to improve the Egyptian onion industry. Franklin is the author or co-author of more than 50 scientific articles and publications. His honors include the Idaho Daily Statesman Distinguished Citizen Award in 1965, the Pacific Seedsmen's Association's Man of the Year Award in 1968, and the Idaho-Eastern Oregon Seed Association Award for Distinguished Service in 1970. He is past president of the Northwest Society of Horticulturists, Entomologists, and Plant Pathologists. He has served on the Idaho Rural Development Committee, National Onion Seed Production Committee, Fruit Commodities Research Committee and Vegetable Commodities Research Committee. He is past chairman of the National Carrot Breeders Association and was secretary of the Idaho Seed Council from its organization in 1955 until 1973.

Homer I. Futter, Extension Professor Emeritus

Home Futter has served Latah County residents for 18 years as extension agricultural agent. Professor Futter's association with the University goes back much farther because in 1948 he received his bachelor's degree in animal husbandry from the University. He joined the University of Idaho Cooperative Extension service right after graduation as Lemhi County extension agricultural agent. Later he resigned that position to become a representative of a Pacific Northwest flour manufacturing firm. He rejoined the University faculty in 1954 when he was appointed assistant agricultural agent in Idaho County. He has become well known for his strong program in soil conservation and was recognized for his efforts when he received the Latah Soil Conservation Service District Distinguished Service Award in 1973. His extension work also emphasized weed control and seed improvement programs. He is a past president of the North Idaho Swine Breeders.

Cedric E. Gregory, Professor of Mining Engineering Emeritus

Dr. Gregory joined the University staff in 1968 with a broad international background. A native of Adelaide, South Australia, he holds bachelor's degrees in three fields — engineering (mining), arts (Latin and mathematics) and economics (economics and political science) from Australian universities. He also holds a master of engineering degree from the University of Queensland and a doctor of philosophy degree from the same school. He is a specialist in mine ventilation and mine management and had considerable industrial and administrative experience before entering the academic field. He began his teaching career at the University of Queensland in 1956 and served as acting head/acting professor of that School of Engineering at two different times. In 1967 he was appointed a professor of mining engineering at the Colorado School of Mines and came to the University the following year. He is a member of

many professional organizations including the Institution of Mining and Metallurgy, the Canadian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, the American Institute of Mining, Metallurgical and Petroleum Engineers, the Mining Institute of Scotland and the Mine Ventilation Society of South Africa. He is a fellow in the Institution of Mining Engineers, the South African Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, the Institution of Engineers, Australia, and the Australian Institute of Management. He is a registered professional engineer, a chartered engineer and holds a Metalliferous Mine Manager's Certificate for Queensland and New Guinea. During his career, he has acquired much overseas experience including attending the Fifth International Mining Congress at Moscow, USSR, in 1967.

Robert E. Hosack, Professor of Political

Science and Department Chairman Emeritus

Dr. Hosack served as chairman of the University of Idaho Political Science Department for 20 years. He came to the University in 1944 as an instructor of political science and became assistant professor and acting chairman of the political science department three years later. He has devoted most of his professional career to his work at the University and has seen the political science department grow in numbers and in areas of interest. In 1953 he was promoted to professor and added the title of head of Department of Social Sciences in 1955. In 1969 the department was reorganized and Dr. Hosack became head of the Department of Political Science and Public Affairs Research. In 1967 he was awarded a Fulbright travel grant for research on the provinicial government of Taiwan. He served as a visiting professor of political science at Tunghai University in Taichung, Taiwan, during that sabbatical leave Dr. Hosack is listed in Who's Who and Who's Who in the West and belongs to a number of honoraries including Phi Beta Kappa. He is past president of the Inland Empire Branch of IPR and of the University of Idaho chapter of the AAUP. He belongs to a number of other professional societies and has been a trustee of the Northwest Scientific Association and past president of the Pacific Northwest Political Science Association. He is a member of the Editorial Advisory Board of Free World Forum, Washington D.C. Dr. Hosack holds a bachelor's degree from College of Wooster, a master's degree from the University of Chicago and a Ph.D. from Duke University. Before joining the University faculty, he was a part-time instructor at Duke University.

Glenn R. Kunkel, Extension Professor Emeritus

Professor Kunkel has been agricultural agent at the Fort Hall Indian Reservation throughout his 17 years of service to the University of Idaho. He is chairman of a three-member reservation extension staff and has received national recognition for his work with the Fort Hall Shoshone-Bannock Indian tribal members. Professor Kunkel was awarded the Distinguished Service Award of the National Association of County Agricultural Agents. Among activities cited in his selection as a national award winner was work he has done to help tribal members improve their beef cattle operations and increased participation of Indian boys and girls in 4-H work. He is a past director of the Idaho County Agents' Association Eastern District and past chairman

of the state organization's program and professional training committees. Prior to joining the University of Idaho Cooperative Extension Service he was a high school vocational agriculture instructor, a veterans' on-the-farm teacher, a dairy association manager and a farmer. He has a bachelor's degree in agriculture from the University of Idaho and also attended Colorado State University and Idaho State University.

James W. Martin, Professor of Agricultural Engineering and Department Head Emeritus

Professor Martin has been a University of Idaho faculty member for 27 years. He came to the University as head of the Agricultural Engineering Department in 1946 from Kansas State University where he was an associate professor of agricultural engineering. He served as department head for 20 years before resigning to teach full time. Professor Martin earned two bachelor's degrees — in agricultural engineering and electrical engineering — at Kansas State University. He received a master's degree in agricultural and civil engineering from Iowa State University and took advanced mechanical engineering courses at the University of Illinois. Professor Martin was a World War II U.S. Navy lieutenant commander and was a John Deere Company engineer for several years. He is a registered professional engineer in Kansas and Idaho and plans to continue work in promoting farm safety, especially in improving farm equipment safety features. He is author or co-author of numerous educational publications including a textbook he published with a colleague in 1955. Professor Martin's honors and awards include being named a Fellow of the American Society of Agricultural Engineers in 1968. He served that organization as vice-president for three years. He was also named 1970 Agricultural Engineer of the Year by the Inland Empire Section of ASAE. Professor Martin also is a member of numerous scientific and honorary societies.

Joseph Newton, Professor of Metallurgy Emeritus

After 42 years of service to the University of Idaho, Professor Newton is retiring from the College of Mines. Professor Newton joined the University staff in 1932 as an instructor, was promoted to professor in 1945 and has been assistant dean of the College of Mines since 1970. A native of Butte, Montana, he received his bachelor's degree in metallurgical engineering from the Montana College of Mineral Science and Technology in 1930 and his master's degree from the University of Idaho in 1931. He is the author of three text books and numerous articles and has received Outstanding Faculty Awards three times. He is a member of AIME, Sigma Xi, Sigma Tau, Phi Kappa Phi, AAUP and the Idaho Academy of Science. He is past vice president and president of the Idaho Sigma Xi chapter and is secretary-treasurer for Phi Kappa Phi. He is also past president of the University of Idaho Faculty Club.

Roland W. Portman, Extension Professor and Extension Entomologist Emeritus

Professor Portman's career with the University of Idaho spans nearly a quarter century. Portman joined the UI staff in 1949 as state extension entomologist. During the years his broadening responsibilities included the duties of pesticide coordinator and survey entomologist. As pesticide coordinator, he has been the state's resource person with up-to-date information about what pesticides and dosages are effective and can be legally used. That responsibility has become increasingly important with growing environmental concerns. His work as survey entomologist required that he keep abreast of insect activity in the state. Thus informed, he could spread the alert when control measures were required and help hold down crop losses. One of his major responsibilities has been to train county extension agents in insect recognition and control. Portman credits the agents with much of the success in restricting insect outbreaks and preventing them from spreading statewide. Throughout the years, Portman has contributed to the scientific literature on insects. He has had more than 50 scientific papers published. Prior to joining the University of Idaho faculty, he was research entomologist at the University of Missouri for seven years. He has also worked for various federal agencies. He has two degrees in entomology — a bachelor's degree from Colorado State University and a master's degree from Kansas State University.

Beatrice Stalker, Extension Professor Emerita

A graduate of the University of Idaho with a bachelor's degree in home economics, Beatrice Stalker has been Ada County extension home economist since 1965. She joined the University of Idaho Cooperative Extension Service in 1959 when she was appointed home economist for Payette County where she served until her Ada County appointment. Her career includes working several months for the Indian Service at Fort Lapwai Agency in Idaho and a year with the Idaho Emergency Relief Administration at Idaho Falls. For 10 years, Professor Stalker was a state home management supervisor with the Farmers Home Administration in Idaho and for a decade was on the West Coast home economics staff of the Maytag Company. Her career includes work as a home service supervisor for Washington Water Power Company of Spokane and she has also been a home economics teacher in Gooding and Ashton high schools. She is past treasurer of the Idaho Home Economics Association. She has served on the National Association of Extension Home Economists' nominating and recruitment committees and received a Distinguished Service Award from that association.

Clyde H. Stranahan, Extension Professor Emeritus

A native of Lewiston, Idaho, where he grew up on a truck garden farm, Professor Stranahan received his bachelor's degree in agriculture from the University of Idaho in 1940. He joined the University staff as Clearwater County extension agricultural agent three years later. He interrupted his extension service to serve in the U.S. Navy from 1944-46, then returned to University employment as Kootenai County extension agricultural agent, a position he held until his retirement. While in Kootenai County, Professor Stranahan was instrumental in organizing the Washington and Idaho Intermountain Grass Growers. He worked to build a lawn grass seed industry in Kootenai County to a present acreage between 18,000 and 19,000, which is about 85 percent of the crop grown in Idaho. In connection with grass seed production, he has worked on determining ways to best remove thatch compatible with the ecology and economics of the industry. Professor Stranahan has assisted in developing biological control

of goat weed in Kootenai County resulting in increased forage yields from pastures. He is a past president of the Idaho County Agents Association and a former member of the Idaho Extension Advisory Committee.

Milton B. Weston, Extension Professor Emeritus

Professor Weston has been Bingham County agricultural extension agent since 1946. He received his bachelor's degree in animal husbandry from Utah State Agricultural College where he also did graduate work. He has also attended Colorado State University and the University of Idaho. A former Smithfield, Utah, junior

high agriculture teacher, he also taught agriculture and science at Challis and Ririe, Idaho, and was vocational agriculture teacher at Moreland High School before joining the University staff. A native of Laketown, Utah, he also worked as manager of a feed mill and as assistant manager of a Logan, Utah, flour mill. Professor Weston helped organize the Idaho Potato Producers and for the first two years following organization served as secretary. In 1966 he received the National County Agents Association Distinguished Service Award. He also was the 1973 Western Region Extension Program Committee vice-chairman.

Significance of Academic Costume

DOCTORS wear the round, bell sleeve; the gown is faced down the front and barred on the sleeves with black velvet or velvet of color indicating the degree; the doctor's hood is large. The doctor may, if he so chooses, wear the gold tassel on his cap.

MASTERS wear the long, closed sleeve, with a slit near the upper part for the arm; the master's hood is of more moderate size.

BACHELORS wear the long pointed sleeve; the hood is small.

UNDERGRADUATES wear the round or pointed sleeve, and wear no hood.

Hoods are lined with the colors of the institutions granting the degree, or with which the wearer is connected, and are trimmed with velvet of the color distinctive of the degree — for example, arts and letters, white; fine arts, brown; philosophy, blue; science, gold-yellow; music, pink; agriculture, maize; engineering, orange; forestry, russet; pedagogy, light blue; commerce and accounting, drab.

HONOR CORDS draped over the shoulders designate the students who are graduating with honors: cum laude with silver cords and summa cum laude with gold cords. These are recognition cords and are worn on this one occasion only — they are not part of the academic costume.

Honor Cords are provided by the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi.
