Subject Renaming of the Taylor Ranch

Date July 13, 1971

As per our discussions over the weekend, renaming of the Taylor Ranch to reflect its changed status appears desirable.

The name change I should like to propose is "The University of Idaho Wilderness Research Station". In common usage this would be reduced to the "Wilderness Research Station".

The designation of the facility as a station is consistent with the naming of other field facilities of the University as stations and at the same time differentiation of the station from the Wilderness Research Center is achieved.

I trust that this recommendation meets with your approval and barring receipt of word to the contrary, the name change will be made effective August 1, 1971, and announced accordingly.
