MEMORANDUM

To:Albert W. Erickson, Wilderness Research CenterFrom:Jon Warren, University AttorneySubject:Guiding Operations at the Taylor Ranch

Thank you for the correspondence relating to the Guide operation at the Taylor Ranch.

Your question concerning the University's course of action should Potts refuse to sign the new agreement involves more than a legal decision. It appears from the correspondence between Dr. Hartung and Mr. Taylor that the University has decided to discontinue the use of the laboratory as a staging area after the close of the 1971 hunting season. I would think that a decision for any reason to discontinue guiding in the laboratory area prior to that time should come from President Hartung or Dr. Carter. There may be a compelling reason for the University not to enforce some of its legal rights regarding the Taylor Ranch.

I would suggest that you discuss this matter with Dr. Carter. Whatever course of action is eventually taken, I will be glad to help in any way I can.
