Subject Guiding operations at the Taylor Ranch

Date September 2, 1971

Enclosed find the correspondence relating to the Guide operation at the Taylor Ranch.

As indicated in President Hartung's letter to Mr. Taylor, the guide operation at the Taylor Ranch is to be terminated at the close of the current hunting season.

The point of immediate concern is a response to Mr. Stanley Potts' letter of August 3 addressed to President Hartung. He objects to the University's contract signed by Mr. Watts. It is essentially the same contract the guide operation functioned under last year and which was extensively violated. Thus, the clarification of particulars in this year's contract.

My question is--what are we to do if Mr. Potts shows up and starts guiding without a contract? To obviate this, shouldn't we send a letter to Mr. Potts under Dr. Carter's signature voiding the University's contract offer unless Mr. Potts immediately signs the contract, thus executing same?

Time is of essence inasmuch as the hunting season opens September 11.
