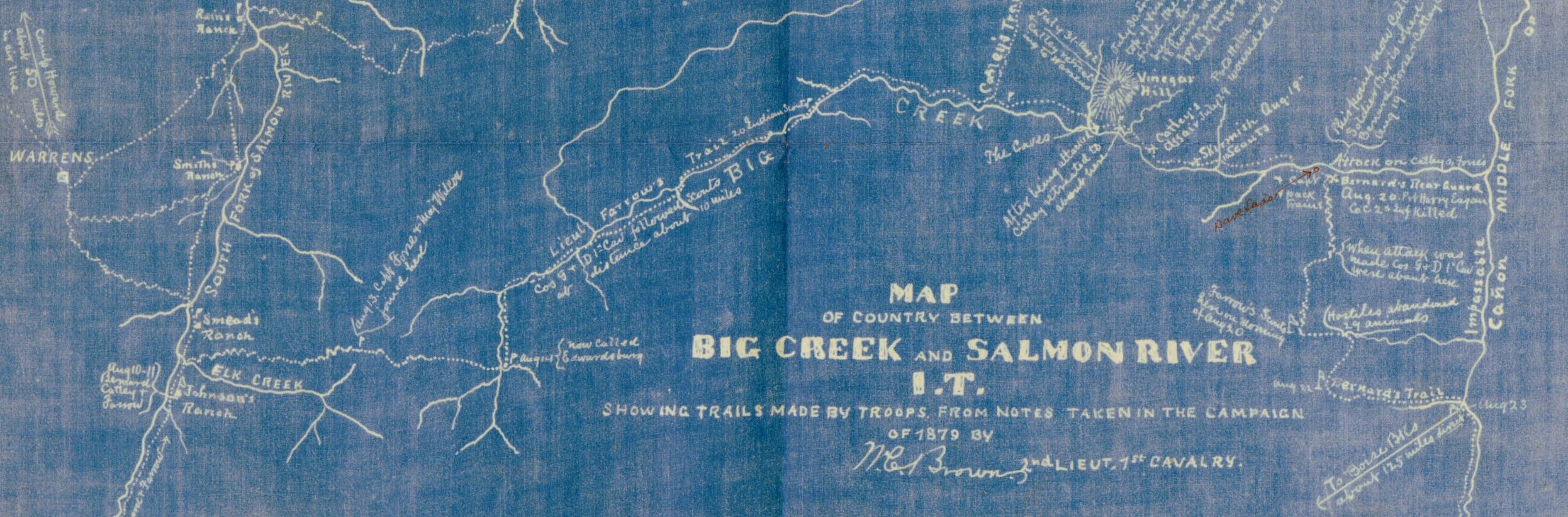
Scale of Miles



The various stages of the Campaign were:-  
 1st Stage - July 11 - Aug 3  
 Lt. Catley entered via Rain's Rch and Chamberlain Basin. Ambushed + defeated July 28. Retreated to top Vinegar Hill and thence to Warrens arriving there about Aug 3.  
 2nd Stage - Aug 12 - Sept 2  
 Bernard, Fosse + Catley with Farrow's scouts in advance, entered from Johnson's Rch. up Elk Ck and down Big Ck. Hostiles were encountered Aug 19, 20, 21 + 22. Bernard returned up Middle Fork to Boise. Other commands Lt. Catley + Farrow returned up Big Ck and home. Farrow remains on South Fork.

3rd Stage - Sept 17 - Oct 3rd  
 Farrow's Scouts enter via Rain's Rch + Chamberlain Basin + thence north east - captured 2 Squares + 2 peepholes - invite party by display of flag of truce + negotiate with Chief of Sheepeaters eventually effecting surrender of 51, all of whom were taken to Vancouver Bks - later to Ft. Hall Indian Reservation.
