1st Stage of Campaign.
Lt Catley left Camp Howard June 17 proceeded July 11 from Rainier Park via Chamberlain Basin to Big Cr, was ambushed and defeated July 29; retreated 2 miles July 30 to Vinegar Hill on the Thence July 31 sang to Warm Springs via Rainier Park & Warrens.

2nd Stage.
Bernard, with Boise Bns, Scouts, Snake R of Snake River, by this map Thence NW from Warrens to S.W. to Payette Lakes & Long Valley. Farrow left Unalaska Acy July 7, crossed Snake R at Brantley's Ferry reached Payette Lakes where ambushed by Farrow's Scouts. Seven Devils Mts returning east to Long Valley joining Bernard Aug 6 near Falls of Payette when both commands left for Johnson's Ranch on S.H. Salmon R.

3rd Stage.
Bernard, Catley and Furse with Farrow's Scouts as Advance Guard proceed up Elk Cr and thence down Big Cr. Hostiles encountered Aug 19, 20 21 & 22. Bernard, Furse & Farrow proceed SE to Middle Cr when Bernard & Furse continue south to Loon Cr. Bernard arrived Boise Sept 8. Furse returned via Big Cr and Warrens to Camp Howard. Meanwhile Farrow returned up Big Cr to S.H. Salmon. Catley (Aug 21 - Sept 21) returned to Camp Howard.

4th Stage.
Farrow's Scouts proceed. Rainier Park and Chamberlain Basin and thence NE to Scout's Spring and 2 passos, immense hostiles capture their meat camp, write Farrow by dispatching white flag and negotiating with Chief of Indians, eventually effecting surrender of 31

all of whom were taken to Vancouver, B.C. later to the Hall Indian Reservation.
