CALL FOR PAPERS

The 36th annual meeting of the Society for American Archaeology will be held in Norman, Oklahoma, May 6-8, 1971. Anyone wishing to present a paper should send an abstract to the program chairman no later than February 1, 1971. Abstracts should be no more than 100 words in length. Included with your abstract should be a list of audio-visual equipment you will need (be specific please). Length of papers should be such that they can be presented in 20-25 minutes.

ANYONE WISHING TO ORGANIZE OR SUGGEST A SYMPOSIUM, OR WHO WILL VOLUNTEER TO CHAIR A SESSION, SHOULD CONTACT THE PROGRAM CHAIRMAN AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

In the past members have frequently requested copies of papers presented at the annual meetings. Generally, copies are unavailable or must be obtained directly from the author. It has been proposed that a system be devised to make copies of papers available as desired. Consequently, such a system is being introduced for the 36th S.A.A. meeting, on a trial basis. Anyone wishing to make copies of his paper available to interested members should provide the program chairman with a copy no later than May 8, 1971. Shortly thereafter a list of all available papers will be mailed to the membership and copies will be obtainable from the AAA-SAA home office at cost (xeroxing, mailing, and overhead). **NOTE: THIS IS NOT A PUBLISHING SERVICE.
