Dear Mr. Crabtree:

Your request of December 7 for a representative collection of Hohokam projectile points has been turned over to me.

I am sending you under separate cover a collection which seems to cover the range both in materials and shapes, sizes, and chipping techniques. I trust that this will be sufficient. Enclosed is one of our loan forms. Will you kindly sign the white copy, after you have received and checked the material, and return to us. The yellow copy is for your files.

Both Dr. Haury and Dr. Thompson believe that you should consider publishing this paper in The Kiva, the quarterly journal of the Arizona Archaeological and Historical Society, since it would then be most available to students of the Hohokam culture. The circulation (including exchanges with most major libraries) runs approximately 450 per issue, and thus reaches a wide audience. Dr. Thompson has funds available to cover extra cost of plates, etc., if necessary.

In regard to casts of the Clovis points, Mr. Baker, our head curator, has made several sets, mainly for display purposes. We have found that good casts are so expensive in both materials and staff time that it has been impossible to turn them out for the many institutions that would like them. We will put Dr. Swanson's name on the list, however, and hope that eventually the problems can be solved and quantities of casts turned out.
