Dear Dr. Thompson:

Please pardon the delay in asking your permission to keep the Hohokam point collection for this long period of time. I would like to keep the points until May and return them to you at the conference in Santa Fe. I do hope you plan to attend, for I would like to ask you and Dr. Haury a few questions regarding the Hohokam, as I have no publications on the Snaketown site.

The paper on the Hohokam points is progressing satisfactorily but I still have considerable work to do, such as additional point replication, drawings, photographs, etc.

I sorted the point styles into groups and noted, as you probably did too, that the styles related to materials. After analyzing the collection, I realized that the paper would have to be rewritten and lengthened as there are subtle technological differences in these groups. Initially, I had only considered describing the techniques of the long barbed point; but now feel that a description of the groups will give a better coverage of pressure flaking.

Dr. Swanson has given his blessing on publishing the article in Kiva and I am very happy about this decision.

I will look forward to seeing you in May at the conference.
