The grip is of wood while the blade was fixed in place by means of tree pitch. Unfortunately, the party who attempted to treat the wood against possible collapse (which is normal after having removed it from the water after 5 thousand years) didn't do too good a job. The piece is still rather attractive and indicative of what is usually found. One must not forget how rare pieces such as these are and, therefore, one cannot be all too choosey.
