Enclosed are 3 Akersfacts
 The attenuated one with rear notches is what
 I class as "archaic" - note there is a trend
 to discredit point typology in Australia with
 regard to bifacial points at least. The other two
 are replicas of contemporary hunting points
 with variation seen in fineness of serration.
 also are two heat treated specimens of chert
 showing variation in lustre etc in exposed internal
 mass and one flake of untreated raw material
 - compare them and the finished points (all
 heat treated) with your big point sent in last
 shipment -
