Dear Don:

Thank you for your letter of September 22. Notwithstanding your personal problem mentioned in the letter and, of course, your previous reference to this earlier in the year, we still very much desire to have you participate in the Workshop on Saturday, December 4. Based on your letter of March 13 in which you had indicated that you would attend the meeting, I have assumed that your personal situation was somewhat alleviated, and I have accordingly prepared the program with you as a participant.

I would like to go ahead assuming that you will be here on Saturday, December 4. If for the reasons you have indicated in the past you find that you absolutely cannot be here on the Workshop date, I would assume that you would let me know at least a week to ten days prior to December 4.
