Dear Colleague,

Due to the new U.S. Copyright Law (effective as of January 1st, 1978). it has been necessary for us to change the paragraph concerning copyright in the letter which we send out to those scholars from whom we are requesting a comment on an article to be published in CURRENT ANTHROPOLOGY.

The new paragraph reads as follows:

"When articles are reprinted or translated for printing in another language, comments are reprinted, translated, and republished without further reference to the author. In order to administer this system, an author who submits a comment specifically agrees that all rights of translation, reprinting, and republication are vested in the Wenner-Gren Foundation for Anthropological Research. Because of the new U.S. Copyright Law, and difficulties of administering departures from this rule, comments submitted by authors who do not agree with the conditions of this paragraph cannot be published."

This new policy will apply to all comments submitted for publication in 1978, and therefore applies to the comment you have recently submitted for Unless we hear from you by January 6th, 1978, we assume that seement with these conditions. FEB 6 1978 publication. you are in agreement with these conditions.
