much to meet you. Please do not think I'm forward, I just do not know of any other way, except to invite you to dinner at our home at your convenience.

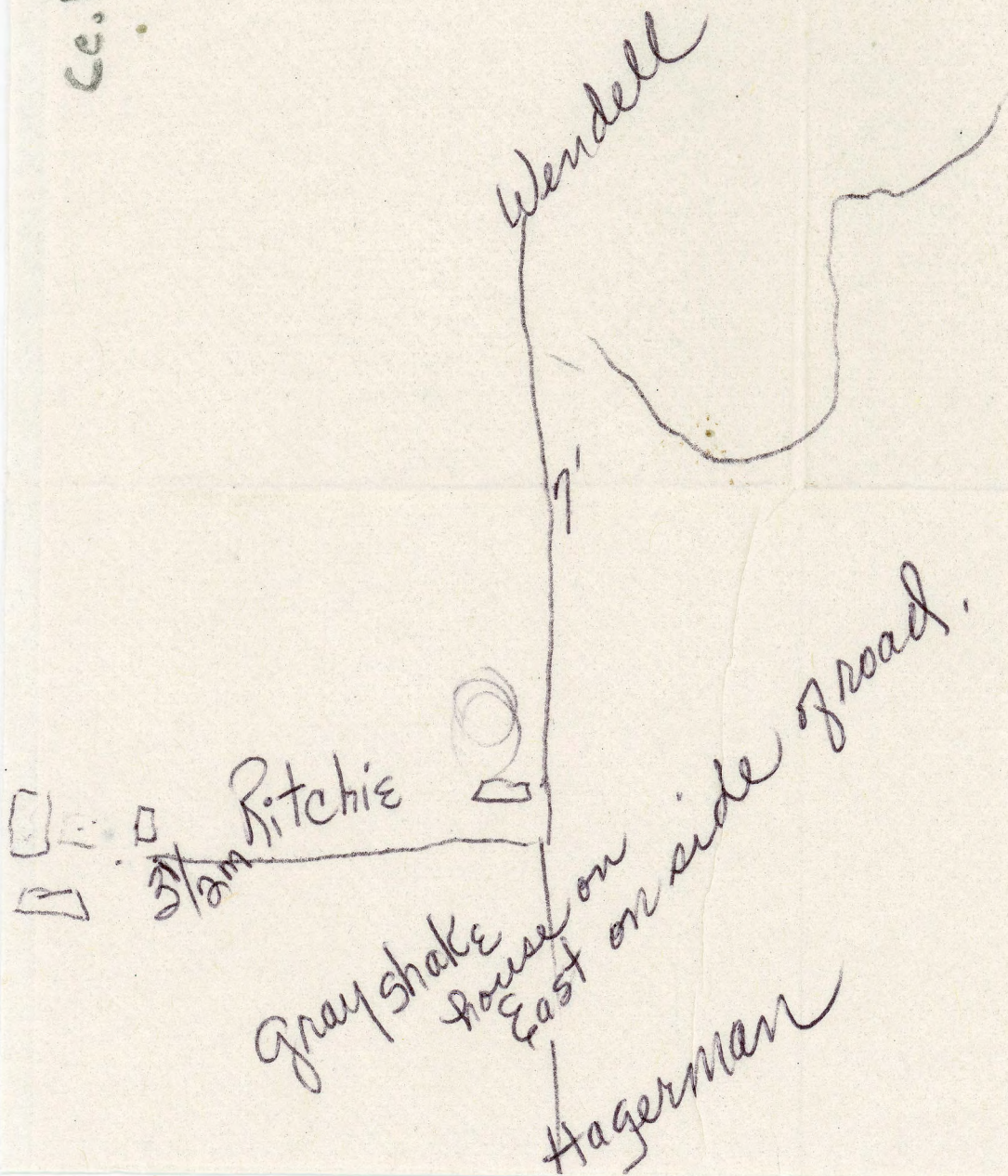

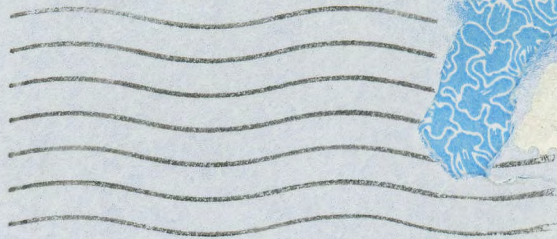
