You have been commended to me as one suitably qualified for biographical inclusion in the Fourteenth Edition of this long-established work and I will be personally grateful if you will be good enough to complete the enclosed biographical questionnaire and return it to me not later than the time specified on the front page. No obligation is incurred by so doing.

During the last few years the international status of the Dictionary of International Biography has grown steadily and many of the 129,000 men and women who have already been listed in one of more editions have become friends, at least by correspondence and even by personal meeting, as a direct result of their inclusion within its pages. The first International Conference of biographees was held at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel, New York City, in July 1975, and the second at the Washington Hilton Hotel, Washington DC, in July 1976. At each of these events every Continent of the world was represented.

In 1977 we are doing even better, with the third International Conference in Florence, Italy, in March; and the Silver Jubilee Conference in London, England, in July to commemorate the twenty-fifth anniversary of the accession of Queen Elizabeth II to the throne of Britain. Yet another means of bringing together our biographees of similar interests is the quarterly publication of the IBC Magazine.

Dear Biographer,


