Jolly Cr more agate - more "see through"

Red igneous sources at Davis Cr
(at Brown's Bench) like Ce 1759

Dendritic material like Ce 1142 in
Simon Falls Cr, w/ 5 miles or so
north.

The source of Chad colony as in Ce 1574
is at Grounds on Bull at
Glenn's Ferry. Occurs in big slabs
in stream bed in phenocryst of gneiss.
