Enclosed are some more - the last - corrections on the Les Eyzies tapes. Picked up some differences when hunting for the French. Also had some help in a letter from Bordes, which clarified some of his statements.

Am enclosing ¹⁰⁴ Reel 4 which is almost too faint to hear. Thought Doug might want to try and hear it or, perhaps have Elmo amplify it to get the first part on side one. Am enclosing page 35-A which is all I could hear on it and will be of no help unless we can fill it in.

If Doug can hear this - then it will be the balance of Irving's statement on the bottom of page 35. The Anangula material.

If Doug can hear this statement, then he need not continue with the balance of the reel which is on page 36 for this is duplicated on Reel 3 which came in loud and clear.

The tapes are so poor that we cannot transfer the French satisfactorily to another reel. Don thought perhaps there was not enough to bother with. However, if you do want to fill this French in, I have marked all the original tapes according to pages and will turn them over to you and you can have the french transcribed directly from them.
