Film focuses on pressure flaking by use of pointed object pressed against an edge. Shows techniques for making 8000-10,000 year old projectile points in N. America. Also notching of small, late pre-historic projectile points. Slow motion film shows technique of parallel pressure flaking. Highly specialized in subject matter (only North American - type points discussed). Depends on earlier showing of films like "Flint Worker", "Hunter's Edge", or other background. Primarily for classroom use, with teacher's guide.
