

APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM INCOME TAX  
AND CANADA PENSION PLAN DEDUCTIONS

I, Don E. Crabtree, am a resident of the U.S.A. who  
is temporarily resident in Canada.

I anticipate that I will sojourn in Canada from July 28, 1979  
until August 5, 1979 and will earn approximately \$ 1,600.00  
during this period.

I anticipate that the period of time in Canada will not exceed 183  
days and the amount of earnings from employment in Canada will not  
exceed \$ 5,000.00 in the taxation year.

Under these circumstances, any tax deductions at the source would  
constitute an undue hardship and I hereby request that my employer  
be relieved of his responsibility to make such deductions under  
the provisions of Subsection 153(1.1) of the Income Tax Act.

Approval of this waiver for tax deductions will equally apply to  
any deductions that may be required under the provisions of the  
Canada Pension Plan.
