

1979 SUMMER FLINTKNAPPING SCHOOL



WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY will offer a four week field school for four (4) graduate hours credit or six (6) undergraduate hours credit in flintknapping under the direction of J. Jeffrey Flenniken (Lithics Laboratory, Laboratory of Anthropology, Washington State University) and Donald E. Crabtree (Research Associate, University of Idaho). Based upon a letter of interest, vita, and two letters of recommendation, six (6) students will be selected to attend this school. Each applicant must be a university student now or have been accepted by a university beginning September 1979. Application deadline is April 20, 1979. The field school will run June 15 through July 15. The location will be the Palouse River Valley near Pullman, Washington. A tent camp will be provided by Washington State University. Each student must supply a sleeping bag and personal camping equipment. Cost is \$27 per credit hour from Washington State University and a \$275 special fee.
