Dear Dr Swanson,

I am very sorry to to have answered your letter of December 13 sooner! But, as Don Crabtree perhaps told you, I have been sick, and after that I had a lot of work to do to get all rolling again, and mainly four different deadlines to meet for articles. Of course, I could have found some minutes to write a letter to you, but I could not find time to think about my possible travel.

Well, as things stand now, the best thing to do for me, if this is possible, would be to come in September, before I go to Montreal. I could arrive toward September 15, spend some ten days with Don, then have about 6 5 days or 6 to give lectures (or give them during the time I am with Don).
