I have received your package of obsidian, etc. Thank you very very much. It is not often that I enjoy working this beautiful materiel: obsidian. One of the slabs was broken to pieces, but I can make arrow heads out of it. Till now, I had time only to make two laurel leaves. It is a little unhappy that the edges of the slabs are square: to my way of working (percussion with soft hammer), it adds a little difficulty, but I manage.

I hope that your health is better now. I really hope that next year you can make the trip. I hope also that the international situation will evolve toward the best, and that we will not become, in a too large scale, teachers of how to work flint!
