Yes, I asked Allan Smith that you arrive in Bordeaux a little before the meeting, so we can discuss some points beforehand. I will drive you to les Eyzies, which is about 95 miles from Bordeaux. The one from Toronto (Canada) is my friend Philip Smith (another Smith!) who did a beautiful thesis on the Solutrean.

I will have about 1000 to 2000 pounds of various flint. I hope it will be enough for the two of us, and even some other ones! I think I will learn a lot about pressure flaking, which I never really worked much, being too busy with percussion. Unhappily I now have a damn rheumatism in my right elbow, but I hope it will be gone when you are there.

The french delegation will consist of M. Tixier, who knows also a lot about flint working, M. Combier, my wife, myself and probably one of my assistants and my technician. Probably also Pr. Ripoll Perello, from Spain, will be there, since he works on the spanish Solutrean.
