

Dear Don and Evelyn,  
Lots has transpired since I saw you last May in Dallas. I spent the summer working for George Frison at the Colby mammoth site and the Hanson Folsom campsite. The Hanson assemblage is really interesting and looks Middle Paleolithic except for the points and bifaces - even got a few 'handaxes'. Then went down to Colorado and worked with Dennis Stanford at the Jones-Miller site and at Claypool. I have now returned to Cambridge and am in the final stages of writing up my dissertation. It's coming along quite well if I can only get my supervisor to read it! Did a lot of knapping last summer but haven't had time to do any since I've been back here (October). My wife and I spent three weeks in Norway at Christmas and had a fantastic time. The Viking ships and wagons etc. are really fabulous. Not much in the way of stone work other than the imported Danish things. I plan to submit my dissertation by April 1st and then spend April knapping etc. Hopefully we are going to visit François for several weeks in May, then return and defend my diss. and return to the States sometime in June. Will probably work for Frison and/or Stanford again. Also hope to do a bit of digging at my pueblo site near Cortez. Next winter will be spent in Dallas while my wife finishes up at S.M.U. then who knows? I hope this letter finds both of you well and happy. Maybe we will have a chance to get together sometime someplace next summer and catch up on lost communication. Any news from Rovner about the proposed symposium in Michigan next August? What have you been up to recently? etc. etc. Also I'd like to ask a favor. Next year I hope to start putting together collections of Lower and Middle Paleolithic and Paleoindian things (that I make) to sell to Colleges and Universities etc. for teaching collections. I also hope to set up one or more lecture-demonstration tours. Could you possibly write a letter of reference that I could use for publicity purposes? I'd be most obliged. I hope to get one from François too. About all for now.
