Dear Colleague:

The following is to bring you up to date concerning the archaeology preservation legislation now before Congress. On January 23, Senator Frank Moss introduced the same bill that passed the Senate in the 92nd. Congress. It has the number S.514, and there are forty-three co-sponsors. Congressman Charles E. Bennett introduced parallel legislation in the House of Representatives early in January. It has the number H.R.296. Bennett reintroduced the same bill with 115 co-sponsors on Feb. 5th. Since no more than twenty-four co-sponsors are permitted on any one bill in the House of Representatives, there are five more bill numbers for the parallel legislation as follows: H.R. 3582, 3583, 3584, 3585, and 3586.

Since you are interested in knowing who co-sponsored the bills in order to thank them for co-sponsoring and to ask their continued help in getting the legislation passed at an early date I am enclosing that information on the attached sheets. I am certain that your congressman will be pleased to hear from you. The House bill number which each congressman co-sponsored follows his name. Four Congressmen introduced similar bills of their own, the numbers of which also follow their names (Saylor, Fuqua, Price and Mills).

I concur with you in hoping that the bills will be passed by Congress before the heavy construction season begins and more of our historical and archaeological resources are lost without means of salvaging information from them.
