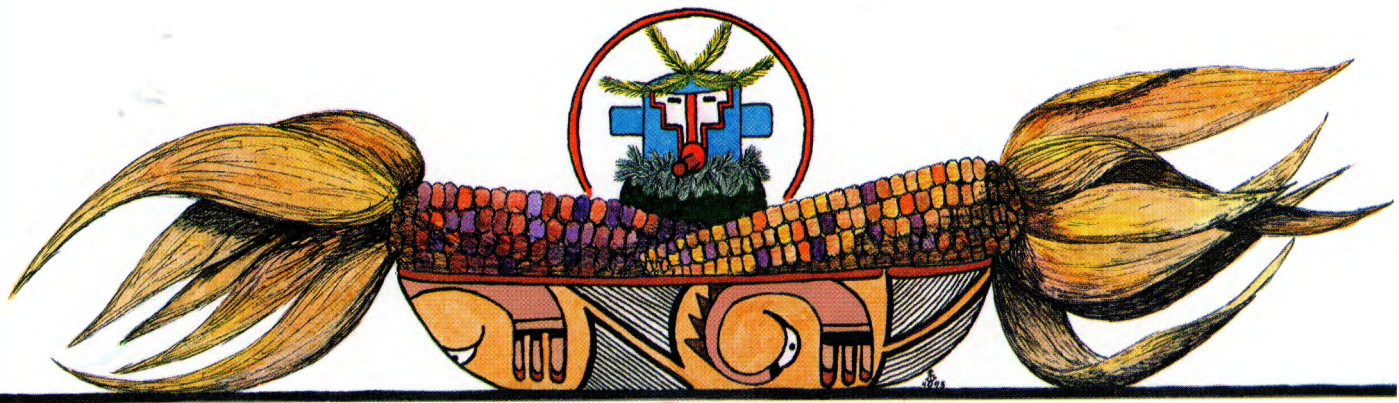

you might have.

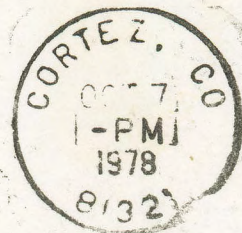
