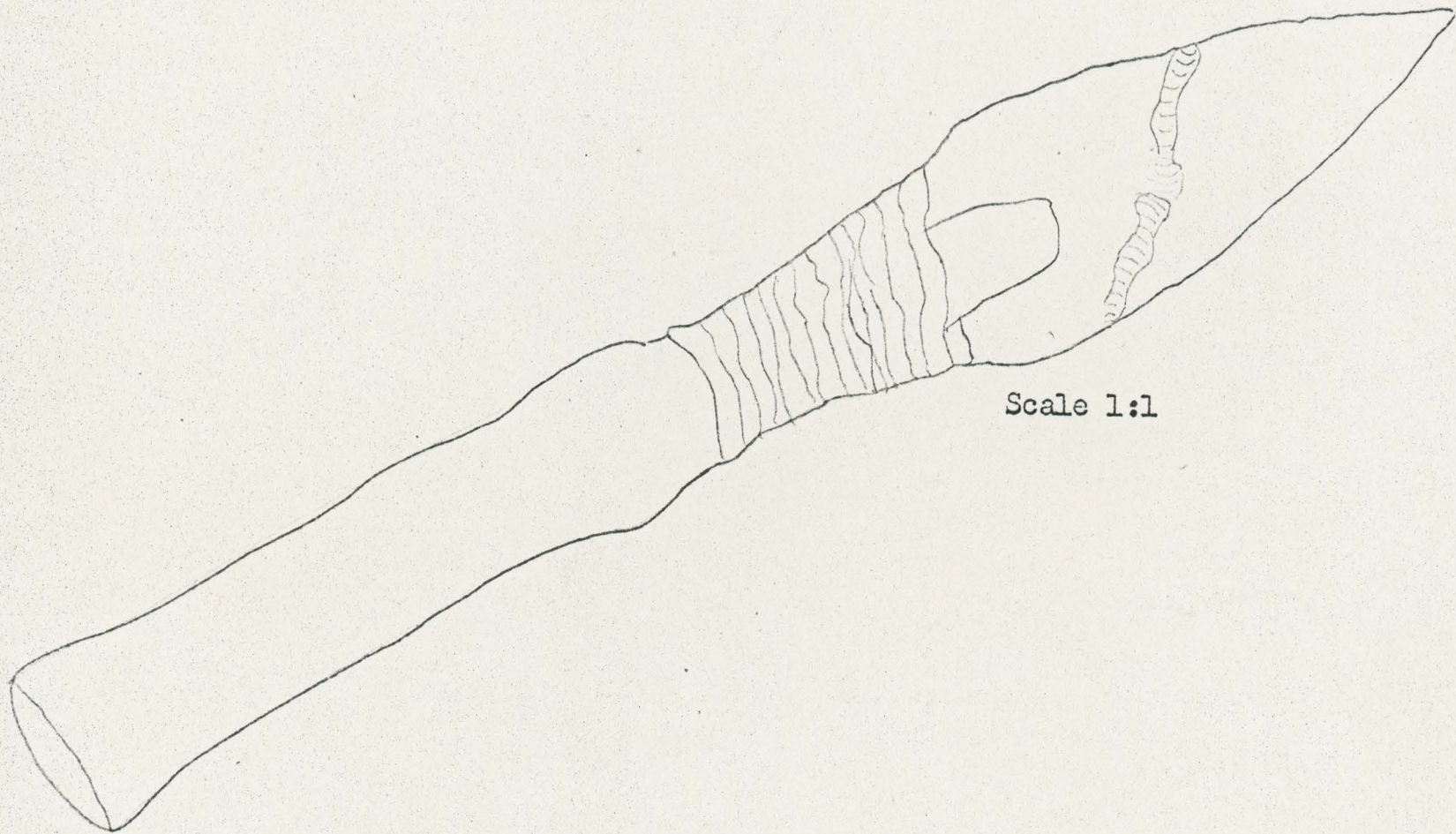

Description: Blade: obsidian- Guatamala direct percussion preform antler pressure retouched copper tip. Handle: Scrub oak- Bear Creek, carved with knife blade and some other stone tools. Binding: deer sinew from along canon bone, prepared (scraped) with stone tools. Length of blade: 10.4cm. Length of handle: 14.6cm. Length of binding: 3.7cm. Width of blade: 3.1cm.
