The issue should be out by mid-March.

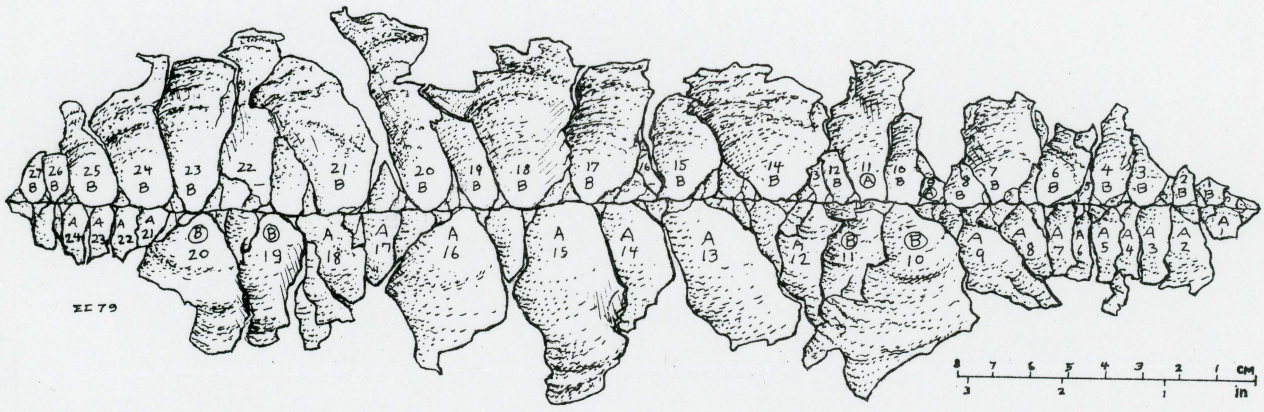
