BUSINESS OFFICE MOVES

► The ESAF business office is being moved to the American Indian Archaeological Institute. Edmund Swigart and Roger Moeller, Treasurer and President-Elect, respectively, will handle the financial aspects, supervise the distribution of requested publications, and answer queries of an archaeological nature. The move will be gradual, and the complete inventory of back issues of ESAF publications will not be moved until October. The move will be completed prior to the annual meeting in November. NEW AENA

► Lou Brennan advises that Volume 7, No. 1 of ARCHAEOLOGY OF EASTERN NORTH AMERICA is at the printers. This issue will contain two major articles-- Errett Callahan's master's thesis (Catholic University)-- The Basics of Flint-knapping in the Eastern Fluted Point Tradition: A Manual for Flint Knappers and Analysts-- and Christine Drago's "The Proboscideans and Man." Callahan's paper includes some 75 full-page drawings and, says Lou, "is a paper of national, even international stature, an instant classic. Not merely a how-to book for beginning and advanced flint knappers, it is the tool that all excavators and students dealing with lithic cultural materials will have to use in site or industrial analysis. Everybody in the manufacture of stone artifacts by chipping will have to own a copy. You will not master the contents simply by borrowing the book from the library over a weekend. Although we will be printing extra copies, my guess is that the book will not remain in print very long." Christine Drago's paper "makes a connected and succinct whole of our scattered and cursory knowledge of mastodons and mammoths... I know of nothing like it in the literature of American archaeology. Nobody seems to have researched the subject seriously."

Formal announcement of this publication will be made in the next issue of ESAF NEWS. Price of the approximately 170 page publication will probably be \$8.00 for ESAF members ordering before November 1, 1979, \$9.00 for members after that date, and \$10.00 for non-members. "The biggest and best AENA published to date," with the possibility of a second number yet this year.
