I was curious as to your diagnosis of the cause of failure as it seemed to fit one of your samples in your Takina article. But as I was travelling around all summer, reading Knapper's techniques, I can see how the math could have screwed up the delivery.

The same fault persists & it has been getting nearly 100% breakage on the last 50 attempts, or so. I'd like to trace the error. I've had excellent success with test breaking, working with the anthro department here at Va. Commonwealth University. Is there any other publication on this subject besides yours 1966? Bonde mentioned he thought there were several.
