Thank you for your recent letters and for sending the folsom point for inspection. Please excuse the tardy reply, but have been out of the U.S. for two months and just returned to find a mountain of correspondence. Time does not permit me to answer all of your questions, for there are some thirty-two conditions which must be correct in order to remove two channel flakes from the base to the tip of a Folsom on both sides. A cursory inspection of your point indicates that the tip was improperly supported and the platform not positioned properly.
